FIRST: The name of the entity being merged is The Lew Wasserman Scholarship Foundation (the "Disappearing Co.").

SECOND: The name of the surviving entity is NBCUniversal Foundation (the "NBCU Foundation").

THIRD: The Disappearing Co. is a nonprofit public benefit corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of California as of May 5, 1994.

FOURTH: The NBCU Foundation is a nonprofit public benefit corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of California. NBCU Foundation was organized in the State of California on December 20, 1956, under the name MCA Foundation Ltd.

FIFTH: Disappearing Co. shall merge with and into NBCU Foundation (the "Merger"), and the name of the surviving company shall be NBCUniversal Foundation.

SIXTH: The Merger will be effective upon filing an Agreement and Plan of Merger with certificates of approval with the Secretary of State of California (the "Effective Time"). The Effective Time shall be no sooner than twenty (20) days after the Disappearing Co. and/or NBCU Foundation have duly notified the Attorney General of the State of California of the proposed Merger.

SEVENTH: At the Effective Time, (i) without any further act or deed, all the estates, properties, rights, privileges, franchises, causes of action and every other asset of Disappearing Cos. shall be vested in NBCU Foundation, and shall be fully held, enjoyed, managed and controlled by NBCU Foundation in its name, and (ii) NBCU Foundation shall assume, perform, discharge and be liable for all the obligations and liabilities of Disappearing Co. and subject to the rights of all creditors thereof.

EIGHTH: At and after the Effective Time, NBCU Foundation agrees that it may be served with process in the State of California in any action or special proceeding for the enforcement of any liability or obligation of Disappearing Co., including, without limitation, any obligation of Disappearing Co. arising from the Merger, and NBCU Foundation irrevocably appoints CT Corporation System as its agent to accept service of process in any such suit or proceeding. The address to which such process shall be mailed is CT Corporation System, 818 West 7th Street, Los Angeles, California 90017.



During 2013, The Lew Wasserman Scholarship Foundation ("Transferor" with EIN 95-4479463) transferred all of its net assets to NBCUniversal Foundation ("Transferee" with EIN 13-6096061), a commonly controlled private foundation. Such a transfer is described in Treasury Regulation §1.507-3(a)(9), which states "If a private foundation transfers all of its net assets to one or more private foundations which are effectively controlled (within the meaning of Section 1.482-1(a)(3)), directly or indirectly, by the same person or persons which effectively controlled the transferor private foundation, for purposes of Chapter 42 (section 4940 ET SEQ) and part II of subchapter F of chapter 1 of the Code (Sections 507 through 509) such a transferee private foundation shall be treated as if it were the transferor." Additionally, IRC Section 507(b)(2) provides that "in the case of a transfer of assets of any private foundation to another private foundation pursuant to any liquidation, merger, redemption, recapitalization, or other adjustment, organization, or reorganization, the transferee foundation shall not be treated as a newly created organization."
