For the Core Fund programs, the Foundation will accept new LOIs on a rolling basis throughout the year through its online application system. Invited applicants will then be asked to submit a full proposal online to be considered at one of the Foundation's quarterly (March, June, September and November) Board of Directors meetings.

LOIs for both the Core and Rosin funds should be no more than three pages and include the following information - a description of the organization's mission and work and a brief, yet compelling, summary of the purpose of the
