Information regarding Contribution, Grant, Gift, Loan, Scholarship, etc. Programs

The Foundation makes grants to a relatively small number of pre-selected charitable organizations each year, some of which were benefitted under the Last Will and Testament of the creator of the Foundation. Almost all of the rest of the pre-selected donees are donees who have received grants from the Foundation in past years. On occasion, the Foundation makes grants to other worthwhile charitable organizations that come to the attention of the officers and directors of the Foundation.

The Foundation has no paid staff. The directors meet only once a year, for the annual meeting of directors, usually in October, at which time unsolicited requests for grants are brought to their attention. Past experience indicates that only very rarely do any of these applications result in an addition to the list of pre-selected dones to receive a grant.

The Foundation does not make grants to individuals and does not accept unsolicited applications for funds from individuals.

There is no particular form that the application for a grant must take. Grant applications should be addressed as follows:
