<u>Deadline</u>. The Board of Trustees of the Zeron Foundation meets in the last week of November each year. The deadline for receipt of proposals to be considered at the next meeting is the 15th of September.

Monitoring. The Foundation requires of all grant recipients:

1. Semi-znnual progress reports.

2. An annual financial accounting of grant disbursements.
