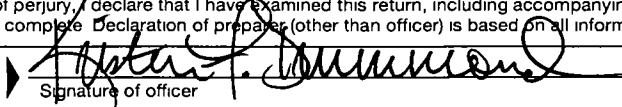

from the municipality of Anchorage, \$4,100 for our website and online registration platform, and various other expenses such as port-a-potty
rentals (\$3,093), Emergency medical stations along the course (\$1,111), Liability insurance (\$1,660), Awards to participants (\$2,842).

Part 2, Line 24: The \$2,274 is various equipment owned by the Gold Nugget Triathlon, such as: waist-high fencing (\$2,000)

Part IV: Did not have enough room for all Board of Directors. Adding Micaela Jones, who spent on average 2 hours per week and received
compensation of any kind. She is a Director.
