The Foundation is a small totally volunteer organization, based in Montgomery, Alabama. Since 2011, the organization has sponsored missionaries to work at Cambridge University namely, Peter and Ilona Greying, David and Sarah Illman and Jon Thompson. These servants serve as missionaries and conduct seminars, lectures, edit and distribute publications. The organization is adding a summer program for theology students and other interested parties. The work in Cambridge can be seen on the website: [www.christianheritage.org.uk](http://www.christianheritage.org.uk). The organization also supports the Round Church which is the site for seminars, walking tours, bible studies and other classes for scholars and university students. The topics for the seminars are a variety of subjects primarily centered on religion and the impact the Christian faith had on early scholars and scientists and the significance of faith in the everyday life for students.

Since 2012 a number of other organizations based in the United Kingdom contacted Christian Heritage to inquire if the Foundation could be a fiscal agent and accept grants for other missionaries and projects involved in Morphe Arts and also the United Christian Fellowship. Several foundations and individuals based in the United States donate funds to Christian Heritage and these funds are sent to other organizations who share the same mission but utilize a different method to achieve their goals.

Due to the small size of the organization, the costs involved and the desire to maximize funds to accomplish the mission of the Foundation no audit is conducted. Donors give to the organization and the funds are sent on a monthly basis to support the work of the missionaries and programs they conduct. The missionaries work under the laws of the United Kingdom. Some funds are used for operational expenses like the printing and distribution of books, articles and newsletters. Other monies are used to sponsor programs like summer schools, lectures, debates and other forums to exchange ideas on the practical role of religion in society and the impact Christian thought had on the development of civilization. While churches and a few organizations do make contributions, many of the funds come from individuals who make monthly donations. These donations are properly receipted when received and on an annual basis.

The organization maintains only one bank account and has no endowment, interest bearing accounts or other assets. The form 990 has many questions that simply do not apply to such a small volunteer organization. The organization has no employees, paid or otherwise and the directors give of their time without any form of renumeration. Expenses are kept to a minimum so that the bulk of the funds donated can be sent to support the mission of the Foundation. Every effort has been made to provide proper and direct information in response to all questions asked on the 990, but many things do not apply and simply could not apply to this organization.

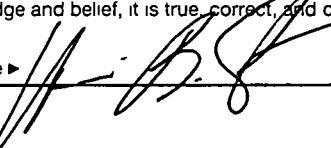
