ORGANIZATIONAL EFFECTIVENESSImpact and its support organization, Achievements Unlimited Foundation, (the "Foundations") recognize that many nonprofit organizations often lack expertise and financial resources to invest in organizational assessments, strategic planning and highly effective fundraising training which will ensure their organization's effectiveness and long-term sustainability. The Foundations partnered with Dakota Medical Foundation through the Impact Institute (Institute) to provide support, education, training, and coaching sessions for nonprofit partner organizations Since inception in 2005, nearly 4,800 nonprofit executives and directors from over 400 nonprofit organizations have learned effecive leadership and fundraising concepts through the Institute programs. Nonprofit Board and Management Training Training boards and key management personnel to operate their organizations in a highly effective and efficient manner is a key education focus for the Foundations. The Foundations have encouraged many area nonprofit organizations to attend the Impact Institute's education and training programs In 2013, the Institute expanded the ability of charity organizations to solve complex community challenges through its training and coaching. The Institute trained nearly 250 organizations and over 800 people, particularly in fundraising. Many continued their professional development in the fundraising curriculum developed by FundingLogic through coaching programs conducted by the founders to build a mastery of fundraising and leadership A review of Form 990s for 24 nonprofit organizations that participated in fundraising training showed that their public support increased over a four year period from \$32 million in donations in 2007 to \$63 million in public support in 2011 Grant Writing Services Since 2005, the Foundations have supported grant writing assistance for health-related nonprofit organizations to generate additional financial resources for their programs. Since the formal addition of grant writing assistance, the Foundations and other regional nonprofit organizations have secured over \$14.7 million in grant funding

ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENTThe Foundations support the economic development of North Dakota communities by initiating and funding various initiatives directed at assisting small businesses located in North Dakota. In 2006, Impact in partnership with Dakota Certified Development Corporation established a procurement assistance center (PAC) to provide research, technical assistance, and training to North Dakota small businesses assisting them in securing federal and state government contracts for their goods and services In 2012, Impact developed a Procurement Technical Assistance Center (PTAC) to provide small businesses with technical assistance, counseling, and bid-match services to help obtain government contracts throughout the state of North Dakota Funding for the PTAC was provided by the Defense Logistics Agency (DLA), the North Dakota Department of Commerce (NDDC) and the Dakota Certified Development Corporation (DCDC) in 2013, PTAC funding was continued with additional grants from DLA and NDDC. Technical assistance has been provided to over 350 North Dakota businesses through December 2013 Since inception, Impact has hosted 75 workshops with over 950 attendees 255 bids have been submitted with 122 contracts obtained totaling over \$208 million of which approximately \$120 million were Native American business contract dollars. Over 830 North Dakota jobs have been retained and/or created through the efforts of the Impact PTAC In 2007, Impact entered into a 30-year \$750,000 loan commitment with the USDA Office of Rural Development under its Intermediary Relending Loan Program (IRP) Impact committed an equity contribution of \$187,500 creating a total loan pool of \$937,500 available to qualifying North Dakota businesses at low interest rates. Dakota Certified Development Corporation (DCDC) provided a grant to Impact to meet the equity requirement under the terms of the USDA loan DCDC manages the day-to-day operations of the loan program under an agreement with Impact Since inception, Impact has provided seven (7) loans to small businesses in rural communities totaling over \$761,500 As of December 31, 2013 six (6) loans remain

COMMUNITY SUPPORTImpact provides grants to support community events, statewide nonprofit organizations and other societal improvement initiatives. Grants were provided for these purposes from established Impact charitable funds and from other grants and donor contributions received by the Foundations. Impact provided funding to restock the food shelter of the Great Plains Food Bank through support of the local Fill-the-Dome program. Impact established and maintains a Clubs Fore Kids Initiative that promotes community youth golf programs by providing clubs, practice and play opportunities to those unable to afford the cost of participation. The Foundations have given back to North Dakota communities impacted by natural disasters. During 2009 and 2010, the Foundations worked closely with Red River Valley community leaders to create charitable funds at Impact to receive grants and donor contributions that provide financial support for communities affected by periodic flooding of the Red River of the North. Impact coordinates with community leaders and committees to distribute charitable funds to nonprofit organizations that benefit flood victims. The charitable funds are in place to collect contributions and to distribute funds to assist those negatively impacted by future flooding events. Impact stands ready to provide financial support in the event of future natural disasters by helping to coordinate fundraising efforts in North Dakota Fiscal Sponsorships. When aligned with Impact's mission, the Foundation provides fiscal sponsorship arrangements to community organizations desiring to obtain financial or other support for their charitable projects through grants, or to receive tax-deductible donations from individuals and other contributors through the sponsor Sponsorship arrangements may range from a project or organization being included completely under Impact's 501(c)(3) umbrella to assistance to an organization establishing their own separate 501(c)(3) organization. Impact offers "back office" services to other organizations Venture Youth Alliance (VYA). Impact, in partnership with Dakota Medical Foundation, initiated this program to unite community funding organizations and private donors to research and discuss various societal problems and issues in the region with the goal of a common focus and more coordinated, effective strategies to achieve a greater impact in the community. Impact serves as the fiscal host for the WA Initiative. The initiative was launched in the spring of 2009 with support from the Otto Bremer, Bush Foundation, Dakota Medical Foundation and other contributions The goals of the VYA Initiative are 1 Convene community partners and facilitate youth and community involvement to increase collective effectiveness 2 Collaborate to establish outcomes, indicators, and strategies to increase joint accountability 3 Collect and distribute data in an efficient and effective manner for strategic decision-making 4 Communicate community blueprint progress, gap areas to be addressed, and resource availability 5 Connect youth to quality learning opportunities in school and in the broader community In 2013 and 2012, financial support was provided by the Alex Stern Family Foundation, Bush Foundation, FM Area Foundation, Otto Bremer Foundation, United Way of Cass/Clay, Youthprise Foundation, and other corporate and individual contributors Red River Children's Advocacy Center (RRCAC) During 2013, Impact provided "back office" support to the RRCAC through processing their weekly accounts payables, biweekly payroll management, general ledger and periodic financial statements, and coordinating the preparation of their annual Form 990

GIVEBACK INITIATIVE Impact launched its GiveBack Initiative in 2006 to inspire donors to substantially increase and improve the impact of their giving of time, talent, and treasure in North Dakota and western Minnesota communities Grants from Dakota Medical Foundation, Alex Stern Family Foundation and various individual and corporate contributions provided the initial funding for this Initiative Initiative strategies have focused on education and training for nonprofit organizations to become highly proficient fundraisers and to be more operationally efficient and effective. Another key focus is providing education and training for donors and volunteers in the area through marketing, education and training of businesses and nonprofit organizations. The initiative created new ways of thinking and new approaches surrounding wealth transfer and volunteerism in North Dakota and western Minnesota North Dakota Wealth Transfer. The Foundations initially commissioned and funded a North Dakota wealth transfer study in 2005 conducted by the Center on Wealth and Philanthropy at Boston College in Boston, Massachusetts. Impact has distributed the North Dakota Wealth Transfer Study to donors, community leaders, nonprofit organizations, attorneys, accountants, financial advisors, bank, and trust personnel in several North Dakota communities. Another North Dakota Wealth Transfer Report was commissioned by the Foundation in 2011, "Endless Possibilities on the Prairie Unleashing North Dakota's Great Potential" 2007-2061, and associated data entitled "Communities with Possibilities" The new study concluded that through 2061 North Dakota households will give over \$95 billion to charity and pay an estimated \$39 billion in estate taxes The supplement to Endless Possibilities is the first ever county level analysis of North Dakota wealth transfer. In 2012, Impact produced two educational videos about the North Dakota Wealth Transfer and the U.S. Wealth Transfer. Both videos are available for viewing on www.impactgiveback.org. GiveBack Website The website (www impactgiveback org) is designed to provide a one-stop information resource for donors to conveniently locate, review, volunteer and make contributions to over 400 nonprofit organizations in the region. Nonprofit organizations in North Dakota and northwestern Minnesota are encouraged to place their organizational information on the website to easily connect with donors of time, talent and treasure. Donors are able to research and identify their favorite nonprofit organizations and to make contributions directly online using their credit card or to purchase gift cards that are redeemed as contributions to listed organizations. Nonprofit organizations are able to utilize the website to receive contributions, and process event registrations. Significant efforts and commitments have been made by Impact to enhance the website in order to better connect donors with nonprofit organizations that fit the donor's charitable goals. Since its 2007 implementation, the online giving website has processed over \$12 0 million for its partner nonprofits Impact implemented a Volunteer Initiative in 2007 designed to help nonprofit organizations more effectively recruit, train, manage and retain volunteers. The GiveBack website www impactgiveback org includes a Volunteer page that provides the capability for nonprofit organizations to list their volunteer opportunities and to track the volunteer's time spent. The Foundations partnered with FirstLink to connect volunteers with opportunities to serve Giving Hearts Day Initiative. Impact partnered with Dakota Medical Foundation (DMF) to establish this Initiative to build the fundraising capabilities of nonprofit organizations and promote charitable giving in the region. The online giving environment improves efficiency to raise funds for nonprofit programs serving the region. The online giving website at www impactgiveback org is used to promote the annual DMF Giving Hearts Day each February and provides donors with an easy-to-use website to make online contributions to over 230 of their favorite North Dakota and Minnesota charitable organizations Since implementation in 2008, the Giving Hearts Day Initiative has generated over 45,000 contributions for community nonprofit organizations totaling over \$10.0 million DMF provided over \$1.7 million in matching funds and incentive grants for participating organizations since inception of this initiative. The Giving Hearts Day event held in February 2013 generated 16,989 donations for 179 charitable causes totaling over \$3 7 million in a 24-hour period. The participating nonprofit organizations obtained additional matching funds prior to the event. During 2013, Dakota Medical Foundation provided \$275,630 in matching fund and incentive award grants to participating nonprofit organizations Veteran Emergency Charitable Fund. The Veterans Fund was established at Impact to receive charitable contributions from donors to support the emergency needs of North Dakota veterans and their eligible dependents not covered under current federal or state programs. Impact has partnered with the North Dakota Veteran's Affairs office to determine eligible veterans and their funding needs. Impact has defined a charitable class of North Dakota veterans to meet the requirements for distributions from the Impact charitable fund as determined and approved by the fund advisors each November Impact supports a Veteran's Giving effort to raise charitable contributions for the Fund utilizing the GiveBack online giving website and other means Since inception the fund has generated over \$58,300 in contributions and provided assistance to 12 qualified veteran families
