### Explanation

Food: for Families Program - Clients with Wednesday appointments are presented a menu of grocery items available that day, including fresh meats, fresh fruits and vegetables, and varying grocery items they can select from to meet their family's nutrition and needs tastes. Harvest House will scale the quantities of each food group to the size of the household, endeavoring to provide four days worth of healthy, nutritious food for the household. The food will be bagged and ready for delivery to the client's automobile at the end of the client's appointment. If a client comes in any day without an appointment Harvest House will give them emergency bags of groceries composed of non-perishable items plus any extras available, scaled to the family size. Food is distributed and stored in donated facilities. Harvest House benefits from 6,000 sqft of donated space. This non-cash donation is worth about \$45,000 each year. Outcomes - Harvest House delivered groceries to about 1900 households in 2013. These households are comprised of over 4,700 individuals, with about 1,500 children, and over 550 elderly among them. About 6,200 grocery bags full of healthy, nutritious food was placed into the pantries of our poorest Tulsa neighbors. Each Wednesday we have several varieties of fresh produce, fresh bread and lots of frozen meats and vegetables to ensure a healthy variety of foods for the menu. We expect to achieve growth in outcomes for this program in 2014.

### Explanation

Clothing and Household Goods Program - Harvest House receives donations of clothing and household items from various sources. Occasionally a retailer will donate a large amount of new clothing. These items are carefully sorted and only high quality gently used or new items will be cleaned, sorted and placed on clothing racks organized by season, style, garment type, color and size. These items are displayed to enable our clients to have a quality shopping experience selecting the items that are needed by their household members. We endeavor to give the client a shopping experience equivalent to any nice second-hand clothing store. Clients generally take home one shopping bag of clothing items per household member and another bag of household goods, but extenuating circumstances are taken into consideration as needs are addressed. Outcomes - Not every client presents a need for clothing, but over 90% elect to shop in this department as part of their appointment. On average we see about ten items of clothing selected for each client visit, and we gave over 20,000 clothing items to our needy clients in 2013. This clothing originates from one of the churches in the area or the community. Occasionally a retailer will donate out of season clothing. We purchase items of clothing our clients need the most but seem never to be donated, such as underwear and socks or adult diapers.

### Explanation

Utilities Program - Our clients are often forced to choose between food for their families, clothes for the household and paying for utilities. With Oklahoma's extreme weather conditions in both winter and summer, heat and electricity are vital for comfort, but can become a life support issue, especially if young children or elderly family members are in the household. Harvest House can contribute limited financial assistance in the form of utility bill payments on behalf of our clients if their utilities are about to be disconnected. Although we cannot pay the entire bill in most cases, the payments we make usually result in gaining another month for the client to make the full payment and have continued utility service. We believe this is a vital program that we would like to expand further in 2014 and beyond. Outcomes - In 2013 we assisted about 475 client households with their utility bills for service that was about to be cut off. Loss of heating in winter or electricity in summer can be life-threatening to the elderly, the infirmed or infants. And most of our client households include one or more of these categories of individuals. Although we only have funds to pay \$25 of the client's bill, we know all the other agencies that will assist on utility bills and we direct or refer our clients accordingly so they can get the balance of the bill paid.

### Explanation

Transportation Assistance Program - When a client has a confirmed job interview or medical appointment, but does not have the means to transport himself to and from that appointment, Harvest House will give the client bus tokens (or sometimes a gasoline card from Quik Trip) to enable him to be present of that appointment. Since we have very limited financial resources, we must make phone calls to verify these appointments before this assistance is delivered. Wed do not advertise or promote this program, but when an interviewer becomes aware of these circumstances we can offer this help to our client. This is another worthy program that should be expanded with more financial resource availability. Outcomes - We assisted about 250 clients with transportation needs in 2013. For those without access to automobiles who have no other means of transportation but who have documented doctor's appointments or job interviews we provide bus tokens. If they have access to an automobile but cannot get to these appointments due to a lack of funds for gasoline we give a gas card from Quik Trip.

Infant Services Program - Infant Services provides infant formula, baby and toddler food, diapers, blankets, clothing and basic necessities for infants and toddlers from newborn to age three. Based on availability of items, we provide a week's supply of diapers, two cans of formula, a pack of baby or toddler food, several seasonal items of clothings, bottles, a pack of wipes, a sleeper, socks, blanket or other miscellaneous items, as well as a toy and perhaps a children's book. Appointments are recommended, and we will take referrals from other agencies. We will require at least four months between appointments and limit the total appointments per child before their fourth birthday. Outcomes - 2013 was a busy year with 420 households and 450 infants served. We expect some additional growth in this program outcomes for 2014.

### Explanation

Christmas At Harvest House Program - This is a program we have never communicated to the public but has become a tradition of our agency. Throughout the year the volunteers in the Clothing and Household Goods Department look for special bargains at local retailers and make personal purchases of gift items that are stored for the holiday season. Sometimes donated items are new of like new that are also appropriate for gifts. Beginning after Thanksgiving the program operates every week until Christmas. Each client coming into Harvest House by appointment goes to the gift table and is given the opportunity to select one gift for themselves and one gift to give to another person. These gifts are then wrapped and sent home along with the food and clothing they came for that day. Outcomes - In 2013 we gave about 290 gifts to our clients and their families during the holiday season. Since this is not advertised or promoted in any way it is almost always a surprise gift that really touches the recipient in a special way.

### Explanation

Emergency Food Program - We much prefer to serve our clients by appointment on Wednesdays to enable us to deliver services from all of our programs for the household. But circumstances in the clients lives do not always permit this scheduling. If a client walks into Harvest House without an appointment and the household is lacking food, Harvest House will give them one or more (depending on household size) bags of non-perishable food items to tide them over until additional food sources can assist the household. These bags are full of nourishing food that is shelf stable, and we will add bread, maybe a frozen item or so and any fresh fruits or vegetables we have in our refrigerators. Nobody should ever leave Harvest House hungry. Outcomes - Although we try to serve our clients by appointment, there are walk-ins every week needing food without appointments. Since operate all of our programs on Wednesday, any walk-in on the other days of the week will be served by the Emergency Food Program. We estimate about 400 households were served by the emergency food program in 2013 and a similar or slightly larger outcome will be achieved during 2014. Emergency Food Program financial data is included in the Food for Families Program.
