NOTE 1 - NATURE OF ORGANIZATION AND SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Nature of Organization

The Expect Miracles Foundation (the "Foundation") was founded with the purpose of leading the fight against cancer by raising funds and awareness through event-based programs and charitable donations. Proceeds from the Foundation's annual Golf Classic and International Wine Extravaganza and from other events go to benefit The Jimmy Fund, a part of the Dana-Farber Cancer Institute.

Public Support and Revenue

Sponsorship contributions are generally available for unrestricted use in the current year unless specifically restricted by the donor. Unconditional promises to give due in the next year are reflected as current promises to give and are recorded at their net realizable value.

Estimates & Subsequent Events

The preparation of financial statements in conformity with generally accepted accounting principles requires management to make estimates and assumptions that affect the amounts reported in the financial statements and accompanying notes. Actual results could differ from those estimates. The Foundation has evaluated events and transactions that occurred through November 11, 2014, which is the date the financial statements were issued, for possible disclosure and recognition in the financial statements.

Cash and Cash Equivalents

The Foundation considers cash on hand and money in checking and money market bank accounts to be cash and cash equivalents.

NOTE 2 - SPECIAL EVENTS REVENUE

The Foundation's primary source of generating revenues is collecting sponsorships for special events held at various times throughout the year. The majority of the Foundation's sponsorship income comes from its annual Golf Classic and International Wine Extravaganza. Total revenues generated by special events activities amounted to \$1,301,471 for the year ended December 31, 2013.

Related expenses are shown as program expenses on the Foundation's Statement of Activities. Program expenses amounted to \$132,831 for the year ended December 31, 2013.
