Our grants vary in size with roughly 80% under \$5000; we are seldom able to fund an entire program. Our expectations are high, however. We look for proposals from organizations with:

- A well-planned approach to underlying issues or needs
- A base of support
- A committed and skilled leadership team

We try to be a catalyst, providing funds to help organizations explore or undertake new work or do more effectively what they are already doing. Thus, we emphasize one-time grants rather than continuing support

What we fund:

We look for projects that address a clearly defined community need. We will consider proposals in any category, although we favor those that focus on children and families, health and human services, the environment and the arts.

With our home office in Montpelier, Vermont, and operation in Dallas, Texas, most of our employees, retirees, and their families live in either Central Vermont or the greater Dallas area. This concentration has directed NLGroup to commit a substantial percentage of its charitable giving to the Washington and Dallas counties.

What we do not fund:

We do not generally make grants for endowments, operating expenses (with the exception of a one-time initial planning expense), higher educational institutions (with the exception of the employee matching program), religious purposes, labor and fraternal groups, debt reduction or work that has already been completed. Additionally, we do not make grants to individuals, daycare facilities and school trips. Finally, we do not make grants to organizations that discriminate in any way on the basis of race, religion, gender, age, national origin, disability or sexual orientation.

Who is eligible

To be considered for a grant, an organization must be a public charity ideally located in or serving the people of Vermont or the Dallas, Texas region where most of our employees are based, which is exempt from income taxes under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code (and not classified as a private foundation), or be a public agency/unit of government in the State of Vermont and/or the state of Texas.

When and how often to apply:

One application per calendar year may be submitted at any time. We will notify you within six weeks after submitting your request. If you haven't heard from us it means the decision has not yet been made. Please don't call - it takes time away from reviewing grants!

How much to ask for:

Requests for support exceed our capacity to fund them. Therefore, requests should be appropriate to the project, reflect realistic expectations and show diverse funding sources. Also keep in mind, 80% of the grants awarded are under \$5000. Please know that requesting an appropriate amount is best, but that sometimes we fund a percentage of a request. In other words, a grant requesting \$5,000 may be funded at the \$3,000 level.

How your application will be evaluated:

These are the major considerations we will use to evaluate your proposal:

- Is it compatible with our guidelines?
- Is the need being addressed well-documented?
- Is there a base of support for the agency addressing the need?
- Is there evidence of collaboration with others?
- . \ Is there committed leadership available?

View Exemption Requirements

In order to be considered for a National Life Group Charitable Foundation grant, the applicant must be tax-exempt under section 501(c)3 of the Internal Revenue Code, an organization must be organized and operated exclusively for exempt purposes set forth in section 501(c)3, and none of its earnings may inure to any private shareholder or individual, or be a public agency/unit of government in the State of Vermont and/or State of Texas..

2. Fiscal Sponsors:

Our grants must be paid to a 501(c)3. If your organization does not fall into one of these categories, you will need to use a fiscal sponsor. The fiscal sponsor must be a 501(c)3 public charity located in or serving the people of Vermont and/or Texas, which is exempt from income taxes under section 501(c)3 of the Internal Revenue Code (and not classified as a private foundation), or be a public agency/unit of government in the State of Vermont and/or State of Texas.

3. What We Fund:

We look for projects that address a clearly defined community need. We will consider proposals in any category, although we favor those that focus on children and families, health and human services, the environment and the arts. Since most of our employees and retirees and their families live in Vermont and the Dallas, Texas area, we have a special interest in programs that support those communities.

4. What We Do Not Fund:

We do not make grants to individuals, daycare facilities and school trips. Additionally, we do not make grants for endowments, operating expenses (with the exception of a one-time initial planning expense), higher educational institutions (with the exception of the employee matching program), religious purposes, labor and fraternal groups, debt reduction or work that has already been completed. Finally, we do not make grants to organizations that discriminate in any way on the basis of race, religion, gender, age, national origin, disability or sexual orientation.
