We have regular monthly contact by phone, email and post. The home or its parent organization must have state sanctioned charitable status and be allowed to receive foreign funds, such as FCRA status in India.

Beginning in 2010 World's Children contracted the services of a nonprofit in India called the Spandana Society to help us monitor, evaluate and communicate more effectively with the orphanages and hostels we support in India.

The 43 orphanages assisted by World's Children help WC publicize the availability of the scholarships. Another significant contributor to the scholarship process is a Nursing School, the E.T.C.M. Hospital School of Nursing in Kolar, India. This school offers recipients of scholarships through WC an additional discount of 50% off of their tuition. If a student has remaining fees, they can work off the fees at the E.T.C.M. hospital upon graduation. In 2013, World's Children also began supporting the Sacred Heart College of Nursing in Dindigul, India. They also advertise the scholarship program.

Form 990, Part III, Line 4a - First Accomplishment (approximately 4,000) than our sponsored children (1,000) because we only sponsor the neediest children in an orphanage or institution, not all of them. These projects benefit all the children in the institution.

In 2013 we sent \$123,258 to fund special projects. The largest project funded was the Lucile Colony Girls' Hostel Dormitory serving 100 impoverished girls costing \$25,133. The second largest project was a van costing \$15,500 for the Balavikasita orphanage that serves 50 orphans. This home takes care of the most at-risk orphans, mostly brought to them by the police when they are found wandering the streets. Other large projects: a compound wall (costing \$11,600) to protect the JMJ Swadhar Home that serves approximately 100 at-risk girls. WC also completed roof repairs costing \$10,754 for Little Flower Home for Children serving 154 impoverished children. Other projects: well and cow for Nambikkai Illam Orphanage (\$8,800), generators for Bethel Orphanage (102 children) and Mangalakara Orphanage (179 children), repairs for three orphanages, solar power systems for three orphanages, one underground water storage tank, one motor scooter, library books for two orphanages, garden supplies for four orphanages, chickens and coop for one orphanage, lab supplies, a cow, chickens and a chicken coop for The Sacred Heart College of Nursing that educates impoverished girls (\$4,560). World's Children supports 25 impoverished young women to obtain nursing degrees at this college.

scholarship program in 2013. 22 students graduated. World's Children contributed \$48,005 for scholarships. The scholarship award is generally \$500/year per student. Graduates have the opportunity to pursue a viable career. Students are pursuing degrees in areas such as: Nursing, Engineering, Biotechnology, Economics, Finance, Commerce, Accounting, Computers, Teaching, Mathematics, and Social Work. We have a very high success rate. This year only one student dropped her course to get married, but all our other students are working diligently to complete their degrees.

Other program services not included above are:

Typhoon Haiyan disaster relief in the amount of \$15,865. Christian Growth Ministries-Philippines (CGM), is a nonprofit non-denominational organization that runs the Home of Joy Orphanage in the Philippines supported by World's Children Sponsorship Program for over 13 years. CGM asked World's Children to seek donations to aid their relief efforts for the victims of the typhoon and earthquake that hit the region in the fall of 2013. Millions of people were displaced and in need of food, water, medicine, clothes, blankets, etc. CGM has an extensive network on the ground in the devastated areas. We created an online disaster relief campaign to send 100% of donations (\$15,865) to CGM to provide direct relief. On November 23th 2013 in Manila, a 10-foot container was filled with 600 sets consisting of a mosquito net, blanket, tarp and sleeping mat, ten 200+ pounds of boxes of food and used clothes were shipped to Bohol.

These relief supplies were distributed in Bohol in November to about 600 families or approximately 3,000 people (adults and children). In addition

to the supplies given out in Bohol, supplies were distributed to 300 families from the towns of Estancia, Carles, Battad, Lemery, Balasan, San Dionisio, Conception, Ajoy and Sara in Northern Iloilo in December.

Supplies distributed to these towns included: a bucket with a dipper, food, bath soap, toothbrushes, toothpaste, new t-shirts and flashlights with batteries. The remainder of funds will be used to provide school supplies and uniforms to 300 children in Bohol, Northern Iloilo, and some parts of Eastern Samar in the beginning of 2014.

The Twofold Project for Orphan Prevention primarily supports widows and grandmothers who are left to care for children who might otherwise be sent to an orphanage. Through this program WC provides impoverished families with two benefits for the price of one. One cow can provide a family of malnourished children with the protein their bodies desperately need and it also gives the family a source of income when the excess milk is sold. In 2013 we provided two cows for two families (\$500/each cow).
