AS A GENERAL RULE THE FOUNDATION DOES NOT ACCEPT GRANT APPLICATIONS. THE FOUNDATION MAKES EXPENDITURES ONLY TO DIRECTLY CARRY OUT ITS SPECIFIC EXEMPT EDUCATIONAL PURPOSES.

THE FOUNDATION'S PRIMARY ACTIVITIES INCLUDE PROMOTING THE STUDY AND APPRECIATION OF THE VISUAL ARTS, PRIMARILY THROUGH (i) THE OPERATION OF ITS GLENSTONE MUSEUM ("MUSEUM") IN POTOMAC, MARYLAND AND (ii) LOANING WORKS OF ART TO OTHER PUBLIC CHARITIES FOR STUDY AND EXHIBITION. THE FOUNDATION HAS RECENTLY EMBARKED ON A MASTER PLAN THAT WILL SIGNIFICANTLY EXPAND THE SIZE AND SCOPE OF ITS OPERATIONS.

THE MUSEUM HAS BECOME AN EXCEPTIONAL RESOURCE TO THE PEOPLE OF THE WASHINGTON, D.C. METROPOLITAN AREA AND HAS DRAWN VISITORS FROM AROUND THE WORLD. TO DATE, MORE THAN 15,000 PEOPLE HAVE VISITED THE MUSEUM INCLUDING SOME OF TODAY'S GREATEST MODERN AND CONTEMPORARY ARTISTS, INCLUDING JEFF KOONS, ELLSWORTH KELLY, BRICE MARDEN AND RICHARD SERRA.

THE FOUNDATION HAS MADE DOZENS OF WORKS OF ART AVAILABLE TO TOP MUSEUMS AND GALLERIES INCLUDING THE NATIONAL GALLERY OF ART, THE METROPOLITAN MUSEUM OF ART, THE MUSEUM OF MODERN ART, THE PHILADELPHIA MUSEUM OF ART, THE HIRSHHORN MUSEUM, AND THE TATE MODERN MUSEUM OF LONDON.

THE FOUNDATION HAS EMBARKED ON A MASTER PLAN RELATED TO THE SUBSTANTIAL EXPANSION OF ITS MUSEUM OPERATIONS AND CREATION OF AN ACCESSIBLE INTEGRATED EXPERIENCE OF ART, ARCHITECTURE, AND LANDSCAPE FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE PUBLIC.
