In 2013, approximately 731 thousand individuals took the graduate and business school admissions tests Teacher Licensure & Certification (TLC). TLC is primarily involved in assessing prospective teachers for licensure and/or certification. TLC manages three major licensure and certification assessment programs. Tests for all three major TLC programs are delivered in a computer-based environment. Paper and pencil testing is available, as needed, for candidates with special requirements who cannot test online In 2013, approximately 800 thousand tests were administered ETS Services Provided to the College Board. ETS provides services to the College Board that relate to the testing of pre-college students and assisting in the transition from high school to college and to advanced college.
