VIRTUA ADMINISTERS FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THE STATE OF NEW JERSEY'S CHARITY CARE PROGRAM, WHICH LIMITS TO INDIVIDUALS WITH INCOMES UP TO 300% OF THE FEDERAL POVERTY GUIDELINES. VIRTUA HAS SUPPLEMENTED THE STATE'S PROGRAM WITH THE CREATION OF ITS OWN CHARITY ASSISTANCE PROGRAM, WHICH EXTENDS ASSISTANCE TO INDIVIDUALS WITH INCOMES UP TO 500% OF FEDERAL POVERTY GUIDELINES.
