### NOTE A - SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Nature of Activities

The ERM Group Foundation, Inc. (a nonprofit organization) was incorporated on June 13, 1994 to provide human resources and financial assistance to projects that contribute to the improvement of the Earth's environment and the quality of life of its inhabitants through charitable, educational and scientific endeavors.

The financial statements of the Foundation have been prepared on the accrual basis. The significant accounting policies followed are described below:

## Basis of Presentation

The Foundation's net assets and revenue, expense, gains, and losses are classified based on the existence or absence of donor-imposed restrictions. Accordingly, net assets of the Foundation and changes therein are classified and reported as follows:

<u>Unrestricted net assets</u> - Net assets that are not subject to donor-imposed stipulations.

<u>Temporarily restricted net assets</u> - Net assets subject to donor-imposed stipulations that may or will be met either by actions of the Foundation and/or the passage of time.

<u>Permanently restricted net assets</u> - Net assets subject to donor-imposed stipulations that they be maintained permanently by the Foundation. Generally, the donors of these assets permit the Foundation to use all or part of the income earned on related investments for general or specific purposes. The Foundation currently has no permanently restricted net assets.

### Uses of Estimates

The preparation of financial statements in conformity with generally accepted accounting principles requires management to make estimates and assumptions that affect certain reported amounts and disclosures. Accordingly, actual results could differ from those estimates.

## NOTE A - SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES (continued)

Cash and Cash Equivalents

For purposes of the Statement of Cash Flows, the Foundation considers all highly liquid investments with an initial maturity of three months or less to be cash equivalents.

#### Investments

Investments in marketable securities with readily determinable fair values are presented at their fair values in the statement of financial position. The Foundation experiences investment gains and losses due to the sale of contributed securities. All realized and unrealized gains and losses are included in the change in net assets in the accompanying Statement of Activities.

#### Promises to Give

Unconditional promises to give are recognized as revenue or gains in the period received and as assets, decreases of liabilities, or expenses depending on the form of benefits received. Conditional promises to give are recognized when the conditions on which they depend are substantially met.

#### Income Taxes

The Foundation is a tax-exempt organization under the Internal Revenue Code Section 501(c)(3) and is therefore exempt from federal income taxes.

### Donated Services

The Foundation receives a significant amount of skilled, contributed time, primarily from the Board of Directors. The value of this contributed time is not reflected in the accompanying financial statements since the volunteers' time does not meet the criteria for recognition under FASB ASC 958-605-25-16.

## Comparative Information

The financial statements include certain prior-year summarized comparative information in total but not by net asset class. Such information does not include sufficient detail to constitute a presentation in conformity with generally accepted accounting principles. Accordingly, such information should be read in conjunction with the Foundation's financial statements for the year ended December 31, 2012 from which the summarized-financial information was-derived.

## Restricted and Unrestricted Revenue

Contributions that are restricted by the donor are reported as increases in unrestricted net assets if the restrictions expire (that is, when a stipulated time restriction ends or purpose restriction is accomplished) in the reporting period in which the revenue is recognized. All other donor-restricted contributions are reported as increases in temporarily or permanently restricted net assets, depending on the nature of the restrictions. When a restriction expires, temporarily restricted net assets are reclassified to unrestricted net assets and reported in the Statement of Activities as net assets released from restrictions.

#### NOTE G - SIGNIFICANT CONCENTRATIONS OF CREDIT RISK

The Foundation maintains its cash in bank accounts at quality financial institutions located within the same geographical region. The balances, at times, may exceed federally insured limits.

#### NOTE H - RELATED PARTY/ECONOMIC DEPENDENCY

The Foundation receives primarily all of its funding from ERM Group, Inc. and its affiliates (ERM). The funding from these for-profit entities is in the form of employee contributions and from employer matching funds. The Foundation's Board of Directors is made up of personnel from ERM entities. Foundation administration and bookkeeping is performed by ERM.

#### NOTE I - FAIR VALUE MEASUREMENTS

The following methods and assumptions were used by the Foundation in estimating its fair value disclosures for financial instruments:

- Cash, cash equivalents, pledges receivable, and short term unconditional promises to give: The carrying amounts reported in the statement of financial position approximate fair values because of the short maturities of those instruments.
- Investments: The fair value of investments are based on quoted market prices for those or similar investments.

## NOTE F - EVALUATION OF SUBSEQUENT EVENTS

The Foundation has evaluated subsequent events through June 9, 2014, the date the financial statements were available to be issued.
