RESTATED BYLAWS OF THE YWCA FOUNDATION OF GREATER LAFAYETTE, INC.

(Revision approved by Board of Directors 5/21/2013)

ARTICLE I

Name

This organization shall be known as the YWCA Foundation of Greater Lafayette, Inc an Indiana not-for-profit corporation

ARTICLE II

Purpose

The purposes for which the Corporation is formed shall be exclusively charitable and educational, within the meaning of Section 501 (c) (3) of the United States Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law) in particular

To lend support to organizations, primarily to include the YWCA of Greater Lafayette, which draw together those who are dedicated to the elimination of racism, empowerment of women and promotion of justice, peace, freedom and dignity for all people

ARTICLE III

Membership

The Corporation shall not have members

ARTICLE IV

Board of Directors

- a <u>General Powers</u> Except as otherwise provided by law or by the Articles of Incorporation, all of the affairs of this Corporation shall be managed by or under the direction of the Board of Directors
- b Number of Directors The Board of Directors shall not be less than five (5) in number nor more than fifteen (15) One third of the Board shall be elected annually at the annual meeting of the Board of Directors Each Director shall serve until a successor is elected and qualified. At least a majority of the Directors must be non-members of the Board of Directors of the YWCA of Greater Lafayette, Indiana, and not have served as former directors of the YWCA of Greater Lafayette, Indiana. The President of the Board of Directors and Executive Director of the YWCA of Greater Lafayette, Indiana shall be ex-officio non-voting members of the Corporation. The exofficio members shall be in addition to the maximum number of 15 members.

hereinbefore stated No YWCA of Greater Lafayette employee may be elected to the Board of Directors of the YWCA Foundation of Greater Lafayette, Inc

- c <u>Terms of Office</u> The term of office of each Director shall be three (3) years with no member serving more than two (2) successive three year terms without sitting out for at least one (1) full year before serving, again, as a member of the Board of Directors. Term of office for officer is one (1) year and an officer may hold the same office for no more than two (2) years in succession. Any exception to the terms of office requires two-thirds (2/3) affirmative vote by the Board of Directors
- d <u>Vacancies</u> Any vacancy occurring in the Board of Directors shall be filled by the remaining members of the Board from nominations provided by the Nominating Committee Any Director so elected to fill a vacancy shall finish out the term of the person being replaced and shall be eligible for two, three year terms on the Board
- e <u>Special Action</u> Any action required or permitted to be taken at any meeting of the Board of Directors, or of any committee thereof, may be taken without a meeting, if prior to such action a written consent thereto is signed by all members of the Board or of such committee as the case may be, and such written consent is filed with the minutes of proceedings of the Board of committee
- f Conduct of Meetings All meetings shall be conducted according to Roberts Rules of Order Newly Revised
- g <u>Committees</u> Those individuals currently serving as officers of the Corporation shall form an Executive Committee chaired by the Board President and shall manage and direct the administrative affairs and operations of the Corporation Committee chairs may be included in the Executive Committee as determined by the Board President. The Executive Committee shall have only those powers as are designated by the Board of Directors. Other committees may be appointed from time to time, as may be necessary, by the President of the Corporation and may include non-Board members, however, the committee chair will be a member of the Board of Directors. The YWCA of Greater Lafayette Board President and Executive Director may attend committee meetings of the board as ex-officio non-voting members.
- h Conflict of Interest No contract or other transaction between the Foundation and one or more of its Directors, or between the YWCA Foundation and any other Foundation, partnership, trust, firm, association, or entity in which one or more of the Directors of the YWCA Foundation is a director, officer, partner, shareholder, member, employee, or agent or is financially interested, shall be either void or voidable because of such relationship or interest or because such Director or Directors is or are present at the meeting of the Board or a committee thereof which authorizes, approves, or ratifies such contract or transaction, or because the vote(s) of such Director or Directors is or are counted for such purposes, if
- 1 The fact of such relationship or interest is disclosed or known to the Board or committee which authorizes, approves, or ratifies the contract or transaction

by a vote or written consent sufficient for the purpose without counting the votes or consents of such interested Director or Directors, or

- 2 The fact of such relationship or interest is disclosed or known to the Directors or members entitled to vote and they authorize, approve or ratify such contract or transaction by vote or written consent sufficient for the purpose without counting the votes or consents of such interested Director or Directors
 - 3 The contract or transaction is fair and reasonable to the Foundation

Such interested Directors may be counted in determining the presence of a quorum at a meeting of the Board or a committee thereof which authorizes, approves, or ratifies such contract or transaction. This section shall not be construed to invalidate any contract or other transaction which would otherwise be valid under applicable common and statutory laws.

ARTICLE V

Committees

- a Executive Committee Those individuals currently serving as officers of the Corporation shall form an Executive Committee chaired by the Board President and shall manage and direct the administrative affairs and operations of the Corporation Committee chairs may be included in the Executive Committee as determined by the Board President. The Executive Committee shall have only those powers as are designated by the Board of Directors. Other committees may be appointed from time to time, as may be necessary, by the President of the Corporation and may include non-Board members, however, the Committee chair will be a member of the Board of Directors. The YWCA of Greater Lafayette Board President and Executive Director may attend committee meetings of the board as ex-officio non-voting members.
- b <u>Finance Committee</u> The Finance Committee is composed of members selected from among the currently serving Foundation Board members. The Finance Committee shall be responsible for monitoring the investments of the Foundation, assisting the Board in monitoring the integrity of the financial statements of the Foundation, the systems of internal control, the performance of the Foundation's auditors and the internal audit function, the independent auditor's qualifications and independence, and the Foundation's compliance with legal and regulatory requirements. The Finance Committee shall take appropriate action to set the Foundation's overall tone for quality financial reporting, sound business risk practices, and ethical behavior
- c <u>Stewardship and Recognition Committee</u> The Stewardship and Recognition is composed of members selected from among the currently serving Foundation Board members. It is the responsibility of the Committee to work with the Development Committee to establish and implement a comprehensive donor recognition program, select the Win Hentschel award recipient, and organize the annual Special Friends reception

- d <u>Board Nominating Committee</u> At the last calendar year meeting of the Board of Directors, the President of the Foundation shall appoint a Nominating Committee composed of five (5) members from among the currently serving Foundation Board members and will appoint one (1) selectee to serve as chairperson. A slate of Directors and officers shall be presented at the Annual Meeting of the Board of Directors of the Foundation. In the interim between annual elections, the Nominating Committee shall recommend names to fill vacancies of the Foundation Board of Directors and/or officers.
- e <u>Development Committee</u> The Development Committee is composed of members selected from among the currently serving Foundation Board members. It is the responsibility of the Committee to identify and cultivate potential donors, inform prospects about planning giving opportunities, assist in the completion of planned giving donor acceptance agreements, and work with the Stewardship and Recognition Committee to establish and implement a comprehensive donor recognition program
- f Other committees may be appointed from time to time, as may be necessary, by the President of the Corporation and may include non-Board members, however, the committee chair will be a member of the Board of Directors. The YWCA of Greater Lafayette Board President and Executive Director may attend committee meetings of the board as ex-officio non-voting members.

ARTICLE VI

Meetings of the Board of Directors

- a <u>Annual Meeting</u> At the first board meeting of the calendar year, an annual meeting shall be conducted at which election of Directors and Officers shall occur
 - b Regular Meetings The Board of Directors shall meet quarterly
- c <u>Special meetings</u> Special meetings of the Board may be held at any time upon the call of the President or any two of the Directors by oral, or written notice, duly given, or sent or mailed to each Director not less than 72 hours before such meeting. Notice of a Directors' meeting may be waived in writing at any time.
- d Quorum Except as otherwise provided by law, in the Articles of Incorporation or these Bylaws, a majority of the Board of Directors elected and qualified shall be necessary to constitute a quorum for the transaction of any business and the action of a majority of the Directors present at a meeting at which a quorum is present shall be the act of the Board of Directors unless the act of a greater number is required by law, the Articles of Incorporation or these Bylaws
- e <u>Board Vacancies</u> Vacancies in the Board of Directors shall, until the next annual meeting, be elected by the remaining members of the Board of Directors upon recommendation of the Board Nominating Committee

f <u>Participation</u> A Director may participate in an annual, regular, special, or committee meeting by or through the use of any means of communication by which all Directors participating may simultaneously hear each other during the meeting. A Director participating by this means is considered to be present in person at the meeting. Where votes of members are required, such votes may be conducted by mail, email, or facsimile in compliance with these Bylaws in such manner as the Board of Directors may determine

ARTICLE VII

Officers

a <u>Officers</u> The Board of Directors shall elect as executive officers a President, a Vice President, a Secretary and a Treasurer Such officers shall be elected by the Board at its Annual Meeting. No single individual may hold more than one office

b Duties

- 1 <u>President</u> The President shall be a member of the Board of Directors and shall preside at all meetings of the Board of Directors. The President shall be the chief executive officer of the Foundation and, as such, shall have direct charge of and general supervision over the business and affairs of the Foundation and shall perform such other duties as the Board of Directors may prescribe
- 2 <u>Vice President</u> The Vice President shall be a member of the Board of Directors and shall perform such duties not inconsistent with these Bylaws as may be specifically designated by the President, or the Board of Directors. The Vice President shall perform the functions and duties of the President in the event of the absence, illness or other incapacity of the latter.
- 3 <u>Secretary</u> The Secretary shall be a member of the Board of Directors and shall keep a record of proceedings of all meetings of the Board of Directors, shall give all notices required by these Bylaws, shall have custody of the books (except books of account) and records of the Foundation, and shall perform such other duties as the Board of Directors of the President may prescribe
- 4 <u>Treasurer</u> The Treasurer shall have charge of and be responsible for all funds, securities, receipts and disbursements of the Foundation, and shall assure that the regular books of account are maintained and balanced each quarter. The Treasurer shall sign or countersign such other instruments as require the Treasurer's signature and shall perform all the duties incident to the office of Treasurer of a corporation, and such other duties as from time to time may be assigned by the President or Board of Directors
- 5 <u>Assistant Secretary and Treasurer</u> The Assistant Secretary and Treasurer each year shall automatically be the currently serving Executive Director of the YWCA of Greater Lafayette and shall assist the Secretary and Treasurer in duties set forth above

c <u>Removal and Substitution</u> Any officer may be removed, either with or without cause, at any time, by resolution of the Board, or the Board may, for any reason delegate the duties of any officer to another officer or other person qualified to assume such duties, for such period of time as it deems necessary or proper

ARTICLE VIII

Checks, Contracts, etc.

Except as otherwise provided by resolution of the Board of Directors, all vouchers, checks, drafts, or other orders for the payment of monies of the Foundation, all endorsements for deposit to the credit of the Foundation in any of its duly authorized depositories, all notes, bonds, contracts, deed, leases, and other obligations and instruments of the Foundation shall be signed in the name of and in behalf of the Foundation by any two separate individuals of the following

President, Vice President, Secretary or Treasurer of the Foundation

ARTICLE IX

Investment of Funds

In acquiring, investing, reinvesting, exchanging, retaining, selling and managing property for the Foundation, the Board of Directors thereof shall exercise the judgment and care under the circumstances then prevailing which reasonable people exercise in the management of their own affairs, not in regard to speculation but in regard to the permanent disposition of their own affairs, not in regard to speculation but in regard to the permanent disposition of their funds, considering the probable income as well as the probable safety of their capital. Within the limitations of the foregoing standard, the Board of Directors is authorized to acquire and retain every kind of property, real, personal or mixed, and every kind of investment, including specifically but not without in any way limiting the generality of the foregoing, bonds, debentures and other corporate obligations, stocks, preferred or common, and real estate mortgages which reasonable people acquire or retain for their own account, and within the limitations of the foregoing standard, the Board of Directors is authorized to retain property properly acquired without limitations as to time and without regard to its suitability for original purchase

ARTICLE X

Amendments

These Bylaws may be altered, amended, changed or replaced at any regular or special meeting of the Board of Directors by a vote of two-thirds of the members of the Board duly elected and qualified

ARTICLE XI

Indemnification

The YWCA Foundation shall indemnify any person who is or was a director or officer (and his or her executor, administrator, heirs) against liability and all reasonable expenses actually and necessarily incurred in connection with the defense of any action to which he or she is made or threatened to be made a party because he or she is or was a director or officer of the Foundation, except in relation to matters as to which he or she is adjudged to be liable for negligence or misconduct in the performance of his or her duties to the Foundation. This right of indemnification shall be in addition to and not exclusive of, all others' rights to which such director or officer may be entitled. [Following sentence deleted "Further, no member of the Board who previously served as a Director of the YWCA of Greater Lafayette, Inc. shall vote regarding dissolution."]

ARTICLE XII

Dissolution

Upon the dissolution of the Corporation, the Board shall, after paying or making provisions for the payment of all of the liabilities of the Corporation, dispose of all the assets of the Corporation for the exempt purpose within the meaning of Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1966, as amended (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law), consistent with the purpose of the Corporation, or to such organizations organized and operated exclusively for educational and charitable purposes as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1966, as amended (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law), as the Board shall determine These Bylaws approved and adopted by the members of the YWCA Foundation of Greater Lafayette, Inc.
