Wright Center serves a rural population and people often have to travel hundreds of miles a week to receive their treatments.

Wright center offers a variety of programs and services for people living with cancer and for their family members, caregivers, friends, and interested community members. The Center also facilitates support groups for people living with cancer in Ellsworth and other communities in Down East Maine. This past year we also organized with other partners the Acadia Lymphedema Conference at which regional and national speakers presented the latest information on lymphedema to medical providers who work with lymphedema patients and also to lypmhedema patients themselves. The Beth Wright Center was also the sponsor of the Turning The Tide retreat for women diagnosed with ovarian cancer. This four day retreat took place at Camp Kieve in Nobleboro, Maine
