	Contemporary Native artists offer profound contributions to intellectual inquiry and global dialogue and work at the thresholds of exploration in unfolding creative terrains. They are deepening their impact on the field of arts practice and are forging new recognition in national and international communities. The NACF Artist Fellowships Program, during its fourth year, fostered the creativity of indigenous artists, allowing the opportunity for study, reflection, experimentation, and innovation.

	Following its successful 2012 Bridge Initiative, in 2013 NACF planned a similar program in California, focused on bringing Art into issues of Native youth and health Subsequently NACF funded four diverse programs within the state, each resulting in significant success engaging and educating youth and community in art making centered around exercise, diet, education and collaboration

	As second follow up to its successful 2012 Bridge Initiative, NACF completed research into the business training needs of Native artists in Oregon and Washington Armed with a solid understanding of the vital needs of these artists, NACF met with training resources throughout the region in order to assess the resources that could be made available to Native artists. That work culminated with the organization of a series of artist training workshops scheduled for the first quarter of 2014.

	100,000 Acts of Art NACF is currently in the planning phase of 100,000 Acts of Art ("AoA"), an innovative, highly collaborative ten-year initiative and signature program that will elevate appreciation of Native arts, cultures, and knowledge and of Native artists as agents of positive social change in our nation. After three years of providing support to Native artists and communities through fellowships and community-based arts activity, NACF believes in this time of profound cultural upheaval, artists are at the forefront of creative thinking about the direction of our nation. Through focused, intentional work, AoA will raise awareness and consciousness - both inside and outside Native communities - facilitating arts-driven social transformation in the areas of cultural equity, community development and environmental justice via rigorous, long-term support and promotion of the work of Native artists, writers, poets, filmmakers and others
	(Code) (Expenses \$ 308,378 including grants of \$ 0) (Revenue \$ 0) Advocacy for the field of Native Arts and Cultures throughout all fifty states is a significant part of our mission. Beyond our website, our publications, and attending events in support of aligned organizations, we achieved our advocacy objective in 2013 through a series of participatory strategies. We sponsored two Native Hawaiian cultural events, an event celebrating the life of a foremost American Indian jazz musician, a cultural event for tribal organizations, and an event celebrating the contribution of Native peoples to the environment. We organized five separate opportunities for our fellows to participate in conferences either as panelists or presenters. We participated in the planning of cultural events as well as on grants panels for arts and cultures funders. We held one reception and one open house to invite the general public to meet our fellows and learn more about Native arts and cultures.

For 2013, our calculated ratio was 19 4% We expect to raise our ratio each year going forward, targeting 2017 for achieving 33 3% In 2012, we began a strategic re-evaluation of our programs, public message and fundraising strategy that ultimately resulted in a feasibility study completed at the end of 2013 and a fundraising strategy for 2014 through 2017 designed to raise funding in a manner that will eventually achieve 33 3% public support. In 2010 we launched our first public solicitation of funding via a dinner and art auction. In 2011 we launched our first annual campaign. Through the end of 2013, we had received more than \$60,000 from over 500 individual donors, ranging from \$5 to \$5,000 in size Approximately 10% of those individual donors had made repeat donations. Our bylaws require that our leadership be representative of our public stakeholders and mission. Our board must be composed of a majority of individuals of American Indian, Native Haw alian and Alaska Native recognition, and our president/CEO must also be Native At the end of 2013, our president/CEO was Native Haw alian, and our 10-person board consisted of one Alaska Native and seven American Indians. Our board chairman Marshall McKay was the chairman of the Yoche Dehe Wintun Nation, and board member Cheryl Andrews-Maltais was chairwoman of the Wampanoag Tribe of Gav Head The other eight board members were representative of the arts, culture, philanthropy, education and the community Since our inception we have invested heavily in our mission and programs. As of the end of 2013, we had awarded \$1,602,000 to 85 individuals and organizations in 22 states. For 2013, our programmatic expenses were 75% of expenses. In 2011 we held a two-day convening of over 100 experts and practitioners in the field of Native arts and cultures. One purpose of our website is to continually inform the public about the work of our fellows During the course of 2013, our wiebsite was viewed more then 27,000 times by the public. We currently publish a bi-monthly e-New sletter whose 2013 distribution topped 5,000 public subscribers. To further our interaction with the public, we manage a Facebook page that publicizes current events and opportunities in the Native arts and cultures field, and has more than 4,000 followers, and we have 1769 Tw itter followers and 54 LinkedIn followers. Our office is located in a single story multi-office complex in a residential neighborhood with plenty. of parking and is ADA compliant. Our office signage is clearly visible to the public, and our door is kept open during office hours of 8 30am to 5 30pm Monday through Friday We welcome drop-in visitors. We regularly field general telephone inquiries from the public on the subject of Native arts and cultures, and provide direction where possible
