The program was listed in the 2011 and 2012 FORM 990. 2013 Accomplishments: Seven women have commercialized businesses with funds from the program and 7 more were approved for loans by the end of 2013. Despite a variety of technical challenges, most have established strong enterprises. Businesses cover a wide range of activities: animal production (chickens, rabbits, pigs), vegetable production, fish farming and agro processing. The program has also been highly successful in attracting more women to the Songhai Centre. Female enrollment at the first campus to start the program has grown from 6% to 34% - a 5-fold increase. Based on the success, the program has been expanded to all 4 Songhai campuses in Benin. Rock Pads Sanitary Pads Program - \$7,162 Objective: To provide sanitary pads to teenage girls in combination with sex education, facilitating their completion of secondary school. The single largest determinant of a girl's lifetime earning potential is how far she gets through school before getting married and beginning a family. The program was listed in the 2011 and 2012 FORM 990. Rock Pads Sanitary Pads Program (continued) 2013 Accomplishments: In partnership with Lunapads "One 4 Her" program and the Little Rock ECD Centre, 2,000 girls from Kibera, Kenya's largest slum, received kits of reusable sanitary pads. The pads were produced at AfriPads, a grass roots business in Uganda employing 60 women, and paid by Lunapads. Eliminate Poverty NOW provided the under pants, mesh drying bags, and wash buckets to complete the kit. Distribution and training was conducted at the Little Rock ECD Centre. Kuludje Sewing and Literacy Training Centre - \$4,103

The Kuludje Center offers young women in the village of Galbal, Niger, a 3-year training program in a range of sewing skills plus basic literacy training to be able to start their own small business. This project was included in the 2011 FORM 990. 2013 Accomplishments: Funds allowed the Centre to complete the third year of operation. In addition to providing training for young women at the Centre, trainees took a field trip to a longer established sewing center to see first hand what students and graduates have been able to achieve. Little Rock ECD Centre: \$3,000 Objective: To provide funds for the Little Rock Early Childhood Development Centre school feeding program. Students often come to school hungry. The school lunch is often the only nutritious meal the students can depend on, and enables them to concentrate on their school activities. 2013 Accomplishments: The 2013 grant provided 3 months of lunches to the 450 students enrolled in pre-school. 
