Finally, a small courtyard with a playground for the students facilitates the physical activity needed for the students The Academy purchases clean water for drinking, washing and general sanitation. The students focus on learning fundamentals of education during kindergarten such as colors, shapes, the Amharic alphabet, basic English, and sanitation. The students will spend three years at the kindergarten level in Ethiopia and the Academy will welcome 34 more children in the fall of 2014 to complete the kindergarten 1-3 years in the current compound Part III Line #29 Awake and Alive, Inc facilitated a trip to Addis Ababa, Ethiopia in June of 2013 for 13 Americans for approximately 10 days. The participants volunteered their time to teach English lessons at Bright Future Academy (See Line #28 Answer). The trip was termed "Project Presence" and was facilitated by the CEO and a Board Member of Awake and Alive, Inc. The team was made up of Americans from all over the United States from Indiana to Florida to Washington state. Each team member was paired with a number of Bright Future Academy students during the day to teach a craft or basic English lesson. The team members were able to walk the children home from the Academy to visit their homes and meet their families The team members also participated in preparing the Academy facilities for the 34 additional students that would enter the Academy in fall 2013. The Academy was in need of an additional classroom and the team assisted with cleaning, plastering, and painting a new classroom for the 2013-2014 school year. The 68 students benefited from receiving English lessons and learning skills by craft work provided. In addition, the students and staff benefited by preparing an additional classroom. In addition, the students and staff of Bright Future Academy benefited from the encouragement and support from the Project Presence team
