American Savings Foundation Scholarship Procedures – Updated June 28, 2011

The American Savings Foundation awards scholarships to students enrolled in or entering a two-year or four-year college or university or an accredited technical/vocational program. Applicants must be full-time residents of one of the 64 towns served by American Savings Bank prior to its acquisition by Banknorth CT (February 2003), which corresponds to the Bank's official CRA territory as of that date. The Foundation provides information concerning the scholarships to high school guidance counselors, public libraries, social service organizations, youth groups, and media outlets in the service area.

Scholarships are awarded primarily based on financial need, with consideration also given to academic potential, citizenship, and community involvement. Applicants should have a minimum 2.5 GPA. Applicants may reapply for up to a total of four academic years. The Foundation awards a small number of graduate school scholarships; only students who have received the American Savings Foundation scholarship as undergraduates are eligible to apply. Priority is given to students pursuing a master's degree in education or social service, and who are attending graduate school in the state of Connecticut. The Foundation also has a "special scholarships" program which accepts applications from students who did not meet the GPA requirement to apply for the general scholarship during the open application period. These applicants must have completed a high quality college preparation program (for example, ConnCAP at CCSU) to help prepare them to be successful in college.

The Board of Directors of the Foundation (the "Board") votes to approve a total budget for scholarships each year. The Board delegates the responsibility for managing the program to the Foundation's staff. The Board also delegates the responsibility for reviewing and evaluating scholarship applications and selecting recipients to the Scholarship Committee (the "Committee"). The Committee consists of no fewer than three persons who need not be members of the Board. The President shall serve as ex officio chairman of the Committee. The Committee is responsible for establishing rules and procedures for applicants; reviewing and analyzing scholarship applications; making scholarship awards within a budget approved by the Board; and reporting its actions and recommendations to the Board.

To ensure that an objective decision can be reached on each application, the Committee uses a blind review process. The Foundation's staff processes the applications and removes any identifying information prior to forwarding them to the Committee. Committee members are instructed to report any instance where they are able to identify the applicant based on the information provided. In such cases, that reviewer abstains from review, discussion, and voting on that applicant. Applications are reviewed primarily based on need. Applications that do not meet a needs test may not be forwarded to the committee.

The Board has allocated up to \$675,000 to be used for scholarships in 2008. A small portion of these funds may be distributed to qualified colleges or universities, to be awarded as financial support to students attending these institutions. Each institution is responsible for the management of the scholarship dollars and selects the recipients. However, certain criteria must be met by each recipient, including geographical location and financial need, following the overall American Savings Foundation scholarship program guidelines.

Most scholarship funds are distributed in two installments, one half at the beginning of the fall semester and the second half at the beginning of the spring semester. Scholarship recipients must submit information to the Foundation verifying the recipients continued enrollment at the college or university in order to receive each installment. A recipient's failure to provide this information will prompt an inquiry by the Foundation, and payment of the second installment will be held. In the event it is discovered that scholarship funds are not being used for their intended exempt purpose, the Foundation will take appropriate action to recover any diverted funds. The Foundation may terminate a scholarship for cause if a student is found to have violated his or her college's code of conduct, or if he/she is convicted of a crime.

Scholarship recipients may reapply for up to a total of four years of undergraduate education. Renewal applications must be submitted between April 1 and June 31, are reviewed during the summer. Renewal applications are reviewed by the Committee following the same criteria and procedures outlined above.

First time recipients who apply as high school seniors will be awarded 2-year college scholarships. These awards will be paid in four installments contingent upon review of the scholar's enrollment status, academic achievement and continued financial need. After the initial two-year award is completed, students may apply for one-year renewals for their junior and senior years. Students must maintain a minimum 2.5 GPA to receive each installment. At the discretion of the foundation, a student who has failed to meet the GPA requirement or any other requirement of the scholarship may be placed on probation. When on probation, the student will be given clear academic goals to achieve in order to receive any remaining installments.

New and renewal applications may be submitted online. The online application requires the same information as the paper applications. All applicants must supply original documentation including a copy of the Student Aid Report and transcripts.

Beginning in 2008, the foundation will award approximately 10 scholarships to employees of member agencies of the New Britain Youth Network to help them pursue the Credential in After School Education at Charter Oak College. The network consists of 28 nonprofit agencies that provide services to youth in the city of New Britain. The network was formed as part of the Foundation's New Britain After School Initiative, which is designed to expand after-school programs in the city and to improve program quality. Any employee of a member agency may apply. Priority will be given to students who are currently working in after-school programs. Scholarship recipients will pursue the Credential in After School Education as a cohort. Scholarship awards will provide partial funding for the program costs, structured so that the student's portion of the cost will decrease as he or she successfully progresses through the credential program. Students will earn college-level credits which can be applied to a bachelor's degree. This will be a competitive application process. Applications will be reviewed by the ASF Scholarships Committee using a blinded application process.

The Foundation retains records submitted by the scholarship recipients and their educational institutions. In addition, the Foundation ensures that no recipient of a scholarship from the Foundation is a disqualified person with respect to the Foundation.

Summary of Direct Charitable Activities for 2013:

1) New Britain Youth Network - \$19,395

In 2005, the American Savings Foundation launched a strategic initiative to address the interconnected issues of academic achievement, the drop-out rate, and the teen pregnancy rate in New Britain. As part of this initiative, the Foundation committed to convene and support the New Britain Youth Network (NBYN). This network of youth-serving agencies and community leaders meets quarterly to address common issues faced by youth agencies and the entire New Britain community. Network members work together to ensure that every child in New Britain has access to high-quality youth development programs. Since it was established in 2005, network programs have dramatically increased the total number of youth participating in after-school programs and the availability of programs in underserved neighborhood. The NBYN has developed professional staff training opportunities available to all member agencies; task force teams to address issues including program quality and parent engagement; and successfully developed collaborative proposals for funding to leverage additional dollars into the community. The Foundation plans to continue its support of the NBYN.

2) Robert T. Kenney Scholarship Program - \$67,919

The American Savings Foundation operates the Robert T. Kenney Scholarship Program, which in 2013 awarded \$640,536 in scholarships to 467 area students. The Foundation provides additional benefits to scholarship recipients, including hosting an annual reception for the scholars and their families. The Foundation manages a paid summer internship program, offering career-oriented job opportunities for scholarship recipients. In 2013, the Foundation awarded small grants totaling \$79,074 to area nonprofit agencies to fund these internship positions. The Foundation participates in and hosts financial aid information sessions with other scholarship providers for guidance counselors, parents, and youth program participants in Waterbury, New Britain, and the surrounding towns. In 2011, the Foundation hired an Assistant Program Officer whose primary responsibility is to manage and help grow the Robert T. Kenney Scholarship Program.
