- 1. Foundation's Charitable Activities. The Allen Foundation (the "Foundation") was formed on April 25, 2000, for the purpose of providing humanitarian and development aid to individuals in the most desperate areas of the world. To accomplish its charitable purposes, the Foundation began work in Cambodia, a country that has suffered almost unimaginable devastation and poverty for over three decades. Its projects in Cambodia were initiated under the supervision of Jacquelin Cochran, a project manager with graduate training through the Energy & Resources Department at the University of California at Berkeley where she specialized in the use of water purification and renewable energy technologies in South-East Asia.
- 2. Joint Venture with Stung Treng Women's Development Center (SWDC). As a continuation of its efforts in providing humanitarian and development aid in Cambodia, a joint venture in Cambodia's Stung Treng province was undertaken with Stung Treng Women's Development Center (SWDC) to reduce poverty by developing village-based sericulture which will enable local farmers to raise silkworms on mulberry trees, harvest and refine silk locally. The project focuses on developing life skills that assist in breaking the cycle of poverty and illiteracy for vulnerable people, especially women in the region. The programs offer opportunities that improve living standards through education, vocational training and employment. This year the foundation committed an additional \$40,000 to this joint venture.

Between 2002 and 2013 SWDC has directly supported over 574 women, 981children, 150 men, and directly assisted 675 families in the impoverished Stung Treng region of Cambodia. The SWDC programs now include:

Education Program in Literacy and Health

Education Program School Sponsorship

Vocational Training in Traditional Weaving and Sewing

Vocational Training in Carpentry and Building

Vocational Training in Sericulture

Vocational Training in Retail Management, Accountancy, Design and Product Development, and Computer Skills

Provide Child Care Program for workers, including kindergarten and pre-school

Employment at SWDC production center for Mekong Blue

Employment at SWDC café and gallery

Employment at SWDC Sericulture program

Free Lunch Program for workers – this was discontinued in November, 2013

Child Development Center opened January, 2013

The December, 2012 agreement with SWDC was funded with \$15,000. The purpose of the December, 2012 agreement was to further assist and support the impoverished population served by SWDC by assisting SWDC to obtain financial self-sufficiency through increased awareness and sales of its silk products in the Cambodian and international markets through their Phnom Penh store. The store was set up in 2009. In 2009 Mekong Blue also launched its first online store in the US. Mekong Blue was invited to participate the third time in the 2013 Santa Fe International Folk Art Market, which generated \$17,334 for Mekong blue silk products which contributed 17.6% of Mekong blue gross sales for 2013. Mekong Blue is making a name for itself as one of the finest silk products in Cambodia. The gross sales in 2013 total \$98,323, which covered 70.92% of the annual budget that is needed to run SWDC social welfare program.

The August, 2013 agreement with SWDC was funded with \$25,000. The purpose of the December, 2013 agreement was for the construction of a new Kindergarten facility named Kidzplace Kindergarten. The aims of this Kindergarten is providing early childhood education to rural Cambodian communities. SWDC would like to improve the school facility for better teaching methods and add an essential health care program into the school's daily routine activities. The new kindergarten facility will combine the SWDC kindergarten and the community kindergarten to develop the Kidszplace kindergarten within the compound of the SWDC for both children of SWDC and the children from the community. SWDC understands that good health and effective education go hand in hand with significant improvements in general development. The Kidszplace Kindergarten will enable more children to make a better start in their educational life and engender a culture of learning among younger Cambodians. This will help break the cycle of poverty in this province.
