The Organization provides many resources to clients facing financial difficulties. First and foremost, it is a "resource center" providing additional options and referrals. Secondly, it assists clients in preparing a realistic monthly budget so that they can meet their financial obligations. During that process, the Organization can suggest numerous alternatives to alleviate the client's financial burden. Finally, under certain circumstances, the Organization offers direct financial assistance.

Financial assistance is offered to clients who can prove they have been residents of Boca Raton for at least twelve months. They may receive limited financial assistance in a twelve-month period for aid with rent (they must have a three-day notice from their landlord), utilities (they must have a final notice from the Utility Company), medicines, excluding anti-depressants and pain medicines (they must have doctor's prescription), and/or bus passes (to a place of employment or to a doctor's appointment). Not all clients qualify, nor are funds available to assist every qualified applicant. The Organization has the final determination of the amount of financial aid rendered, if any. During 2013, the Organization provided \$87,782 of financial assistance to more than 300 individuals and families.

The Organization's Food Programs principally consist of hot lunches, served Monday through Saturday to the hungry and those less fortunate (no one is turned away); Family Night Dinners, served every Thursday evening to needy families; and a Pantry Program, available Monday through Saturday, where grocery staples, including meat, fruit, produce, bread and other food items are distributed to eligible families and individuals. Eligibility is monitored very closely. During 2013, the Organization distributed nearly 66,000 grocery bags and served nearly 57,000 meals to thousands of individuals and families.



Part III - 4a: STATEMENT 2: FOOD CENTER

The Organization operates a *Food Center*, where volunteers cook and serve seven hot, nutritional meals weekly (lunches from Monday through Saturday and a Thursday Family Night Dinner); provide grocery bags of food staples to eligible low income individuals and families from Monday to Saturday; and deliver lunches to the homebound. During 2013, the Organization prepared and served approximately 57,000 hot meals; distributed approximately 66,000 grocery food bags to the working poor, unemployed, disabled, homebound and homeless; and recovered more than 1,800,000 pounds of food from supermarkets, restaurants, individuals, businesses, governmental agencies and other organizations.

The Organization also administers *BHH Backpacks*, which addresses the critical problem of what low income school children eat on weekends, i.e., those who receive their primary meal each weekday through free and reduced school lunch programs. The *BHH Backpacks* program provides six meals, two snacks and two juice boxes in backpacks each Friday for eligible school children who attend eight area elementary schools to take home for the weekend. The Organization purchases the food and then delivers the appropriate amount of each food item to each of the schools on a weekly basis during the academic school year.

Part III - 4b: STATEMENT 3 RESOURCE CENTER

The Organization provides a variety of resources to clients who are Boca Raton residents and who are facing financial difficulties, including assistance in preparing a realistic monthly budget so they can meet their financial obligations and suggesting numerous alternatives or referrals to other organizations to alleviate their financial burden. The Organization offers limited financial aid in crisis situations, principally for assistance with rent (clients must have a 3-day notice from the landlord) and utilities (clients must have a final notice from the electric or water authority) and bus passes to a place of employment or doctor's appointment. During 2013, the Organization provided nearly \$88,000 in temporary, limited financial assistance to qualified residents of Boca Raton to alleviate crisis situations by paying bills directly to landlords, utility companies and similar enterprises.

Part III - 4c. STATEMENT 4: JOB MENTORING AND SOCIAL ENTERPRISE PROGRAMS

The Organization helps clients become job ready and to apply for employment opportunities. Clients receive personalized assistance from volunteer job mentors in job searching, application assistance, resume writing, cover letter development, interview preparation, and access to computers and fax machines for job search and application purposes. The *Job Mentoring Program* offers computer classes for those wishing to learn basic computer skills, MS Word, or Excel. During 2013, the Organization's *Job Mentoring Program* resulted in more than 100 individuals obtaining employment.

A key Job Mentoring/Social Enterprise Program, known as Esperanza Catering at Boca Helping Hands, commenced at the beginning of 2013. Esperanza Catering at Boca Helping Hands empowers clients to become self-sufficient, and take responsibility for their own lives by obtaining gainful employment in

order to break the cycle of dependence. Selected clients are carefully screened and, if qualified, they earn a small stipend while gaining skills and experience in the food service/hospitality industry. During 2013, *Esperanza Catering at Boca Helping Hands* graduated 31 students who learned life and social skills as well as skills specific to the restaurant industry, including hands-on experience as they catered meals for various organizations and businesses. The program is provided in three-month increments and graduates are guided by the Organization in their search for employment with area restaurants, country clubs, and other potential opportunities, thus opening the door for the participants to gain job interviews. A significant percentage of the graduates have been successful in finding employment.
