

Essilor Vision Foundation (EVF) Programs:

Kids Vision for Life focuses on providing vision services to children in need at no cost to the family through mobile clinics at the schools, school vision days, community vision fests, and other special events. Events include vision fests, health fairs, and many other summer program formats to allow our team the opportunity to provide hundreds of glasses in one day and educate the community about the importance of vision care. In 2013, KVFL screened more than 61,000 students and provided 25,238 pairs of new eyeglasses to kids in need at no cost to their families. Expenses incurred in 2013 totaled \$2,865,750.

Adopt A School (Essilor Employee Vision Days) provides employees an opportunity to give back to their local community by providing vision services at schools in their area as well as educating parents on the importance of good vision. In 2013, AAS screened more than 4,000 students and provided 1,080 pairs of new eyeglasses to students in need. Expenses incurred in 2013 totaled \$140,558.

Special Olympics and EVF have a multi-year partnership, where EVF provides lenses and lab services for both daily and sport-specific glasses for Special Olympic athletes.

Facts and Circumstances Test

Essilor Vision Foundation ("The Foundation") public support percentage over the last five years was 29.64%, short of the 33 1/3% threshold set forth in I.R.C. Section 170(b)(1)(A)(vi). As a result, The Foundation is relying on the facts and circumstances test as set forth in Treasury Regulation Section 1.170A-9(e)(3) to support its public charity status. To qualify under the facts and circumstances test, The Foundation must demonstrate the following two elements:

1. The total amount of public support must equal or exceed an absolute minimum of 10 percent of total support for the applicable period.

The Foundation's public support percentage for the five year period ended December 31, 2013 was 29.64%, well in excess of the minimum 10% threshold. The Foundation's public support percentage for the five year period ending December 31, 2014 is projected to be at least 33.3%, meeting the public support test.

2. The organization must be organized and operated to attract new and additional public support on a continuous basis. Treasury regulations state that "[a]n organization will be considered to meet this requirement if it maintains a continuous and bona fide program for solicitation of funds from the general public, community, or membership group involved. ..consideration will be given to whether the scope of its fundraising activities is reasonable in light of its charitable activities."

The Foundation understands that it must be more active in its fundraising, even in these trying economic times. The Foundation is committed to raising funds on a regular basis through both public solicitations and grants.

In addition to meeting both of the above requirements, all pertinent facts and circumstances surrounding the operations of the organization will be taken into consideration in determining whether this test is sufficiently satisfied. The Treasury regulations list five facts and circumstances that will be considered as important factors. An organization is not required to satisfy all of the

factors, nor are the five factors listed exclusive - others may reasonably be considered such as the purpose of the organization and the length of time the organization has existed.

Factors

1. Percentage of public support.

The Foundation's public support percentage over the first five years was 29.64%. This amount is projected to be at least 33.3% for 2014. With a leadership team committed to soliciting funds on a regular basis to further The Foundation's purpose, continued growth of general public support should be achieved.

2. Sources of support.

The Foundation's primary source of support over the last five years has come from the Essilor of America and Safilo USA, Inc. The Foundation has received grants and funds from many individual and corporate donors which continue to grow each year. With this ongoing expansion of contributors, The Foundation will receive additional support from a broader range of the general public.

3. Representative governing body.

The Foundation's board of directors has retained consistency from the inception of the organization; ensuring prior members are in place to assist any new members. This ensures the Foundation's purpose and intentions remain constant. Additionally, the Foundation has retained two independent board members in 2013 and an additional two more independent board members in 2014.

4. Availability of public facilities or services; public participation in programs or policies.

The Foundation had four mobile clinics operating in 2013 that were available to public school children and available to the general population at various public forums. The Foundation plans to continue to increase the mobile clinics in the next few years that travel to public forums to meet it stated purpose of providing eye screenings, exams and eye glasses.

5. Factors pertinent to membership organizations

This factor is not applicable to The Foundation's charitable programs.
