Note 1 - Nature of Activities and Significant Accounting Policies

Nature of Activities

Signature School Foundation, Inc. (Corporation) is a Not-for-Profit Corporation, which commenced operations in December 1993. The Corporation provides financial and other support for the Signature School, Inc. and other educational organizations.

Basis of Accounting

The Corporation prepares its financial statements using the method of accounting used in filing its not-for-profit tax returns (tax basis). The method used to prepare the tax returns is modified cash basis. Under this basis, revenue is recognized when collected rather than when earned, and expenditures are generally recognized when paid rather than when the related liability is incurred. Consequently, contributions receivable, accounts payable, and accrued expenses are not included in the financial statements. If an expenditure results in the acquisition of an asset having an estimated useful life, which extends substantially beyond the year of acquisition, the expenditure is capitalized and depreciated or amortized over the estimated useful life of the asset. The accompanying financial statements; therefore, do not reflect accrued income, accrued or prepaid expenses, nor the financial position and results of operations in accordance with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America (GAAP).

Additionally, a difference between the tax basis of accounting and GAAP relates to the treatment of related organizations. Under GAAP, the Corporation would be required to consolidate Signature School, Inc. While under the tax basis of accounting, consolidating Signature School, Inc. is not required under federal nonprofit tax return purposes.

Financial Statement Presentation

The Corporation presents its financial statements in conformance with the disclosure and display requirements of the Financial Accounting Standards Board (FASB) guidance. The guidance establishes standards for external financial reporting by not-for-profit corporations. It requires that information regarding financial position and activities be reported into three classes of net assets: unrestricted, temporarily restricted, and permanently restricted. These classes of net assets are based on the existence or absence of externally (donor)-imposed restrictions or contributions.

Unrestricted net assets consist of contributions received without donor-imposed restrictions.

Temporarily restricted net assets consist of contributions received that are restricted by the donor for future periods or for a specific purpose.

Permanently restricted net assets consist of contributions received with donor-imposed restrictions that neither expire by the passage of time nor by meeting a purpose.

NOTES TO FINANCIAL STATEMENTS – TAX BASIS December 31, 2013

Note 1 - Nature of Activities and Significant Accounting Policies (Continued)

Financial Statement Presentation (Continued)

Temporarily restricted net assets at December 31, 2013 were \$12,992. The Corporation has no permanently restricted net assets.

Support and Expenses

The Corporation records contributions and grants when they are received. Funds restricted by donors, grantors, or other outside parties for specific operating purposes or asset acquisitions are recognized as revenue when received.

The Corporation reports gifts of cash and other assets as restricted support if they are received with donor stipulations that limit the use of the donated assets, or if they are designated as support for future periods. When a donor restriction expires, that is, when a stipulated time restriction ends or purpose restriction is accomplished, temporarily restricted net assets are reclassified to unrestricted net assets and reported in the statements of revenues, expenses, and other changes in net assets – tax basis as net assets released from restrictions. Donor restricted contributions whose restrictions are met in the same reporting period, are reported as unrestricted support.

The Corporation reports gifts of goods and equipment as unrestricted support unless explicit donor stipulations specify how the donated assets must be used. Gifts of long-lived assets with explicit restrictions that specify how the assets are to be used and gifts of cash or other assets that must be used to acquire long-lived assets are reported as restricted support. Absent explicit donor stipulations about how long those long-lived assets must be maintained, the Corporation reports expirations of donor restrictions when the donated or acquired long-lived assets are placed in service.

Expenses are recorded when paid in accordance with the tax basis of accounting.

Concentrations of Credit Risk

Financial instruments, which potentially subject the Corporation to concentrations of credit risk, consist principally of cash. At times, such cash in banks may be in excess of the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation insurance limit.

NOTES TO FINANCIAL STATEMENTS – TAX BASIS December 31, 2013

Note 1 - Nature of Activities and Significant Accounting Policies (Continued)

Donated Services, Goods, and Facilities

Many individuals volunteer their time and perform a variety of tasks that assist the Corporation with specific assistance programs, campaign solicitations, and various assignments, which are not recognized as contributions in the financial statements since the recognition criteria under the guidance were not met. Under FASB guidance, services are recognized as contributions when they (a) create or enhance nonfinancial assets or (b) require specialized skills performed by people whose skills would otherwise be purchased by the Corporation. For the year ended December 31, 2013, there were no donated services recognized in the financial statements.

For the year ended December 31, 2013, rent of \$207,600 was donated to Signature School, Inc.

Property, Equipment, Depreciation, and Amortization

Additions and betterments are capitalized at cost, while maintenance and repairs that do not improve or extend the useful lives of the respective assets are expensed currently. Provisions for depreciation of property and equipment have been computed on the straight-line method over the estimated useful life.

Leasehold improvements are stated at cost. Provisions for amortization of leasehold improvements have been computed on the straight-line method over the shorter of the useful life or noncancelable life of the lease.

Amortization of capitalized leased assets is computed on the straight-line method over the shorter of the useful life of the lease.

Contributed property and equipment is recorded at fair value at the date of donation. If donors stipulate how long the assets must be used, the contributions are recorded as restricted support. In the absence of such stipulations, contributions of property and equipment are recorded as unrestricted support.

NOTES TO FINANCIAL STATEMENTS – TAX BASIS December 31, 2013

Note 1 - Nature of Activities and Significant Accounting Policies (Continued)

Income Taxes

The Internal Revenue Service has ruled that the Corporation is exempt from the payment of federal income tax (except on unrelated business income) under the provisions of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

Management evaluated the Corporation's uncertain tax positions and concluded that the Corporation had taken no uncertain tax positions that require adjustment to the financial statements.

The Corporation is subject to income tax examinations for its U.S. federal income taxes and state jurisdictions. The statute of limitations for assessment of income taxes expired with respect to tax returns through 2009.

Use of Estimates

The preparation of financial statements in conformity with the tax basis of accounting requires management to make estimates and assumptions that affect certain reported amounts and disclosures. Accordingly, actual results could differ from those estimates.

Subsequent Events Evaluation

The Corporation has evaluated subsequent events through June 18, 2014, the date on which the financial statements were available to be issued.

Note 3 - Related Party Transactions

During 2013, the Corporation donated \$207,600 in rent to Signature School, Inc. During 2013, the Corporation received \$179,287 for rent from Signature School, Inc.

Note 4 - Functional Allocation of Expenses

The costs of providing the various programs and activities have been summarized on a functional basis in the statement of revenues, expenses, and other changes in net assets – tax basis. Accordingly, certain costs have been allocated among the programs and supporting services benefited.

Note 5 - Commitments and Contingencies

The Corporation maintains a letter of credit of \$250,000 for the City of Evansville. The purpose of the letter of credit would be to reimburse the City for costs they incur for the replacement of capital items in the School building and for the Corporation's portion of capital expenditures for the mutual benefit of the School. The letter of credit can only be drawn upon the consent of both parties.
