



- How your effort matches Grand Victoria Foundation's priorities

In addition to your two-page summary, please attach an itemized income and expense budget for the effort.

GENERAL OPERATING SUPPORT

If you plan to request general operating support, we will look at whether your mission and overall activities are a good fit with ours and the extent to which you are leading in your field. Therefore, your responses to the points above should focus on plans to strengthen your organization within the context of your mission. Please attach an organizational budget and year-to-date income and expense report.

RENEWED FUNDING

If you are seeking renewed funding, we suggest you say less about your organization and instead include a brief update on the funded effort. 

Frequently Asked Questions

What do you consider an Elgin-based organization?

A nonprofit is considered Elgin-based if it: 1) has an office in Elgin, Illinois,
2) provides direct services to Elgin residents, and 3) has a dedicated Elgin budget.

If I apply for a general operating grant, can I apply for other grants from the Foundation in the same year?

Yes. However, eligibility requirements and program priorities for other Foundation grant programs differ from the eligibility requirements for the Grantworks general operating grant program. Visit www.grandvictoriafdn.org for more information about other grant opportunities.

Can the requested amounts for years two and three be different from the amount specified in the original application?

Yes, you may change the amount of funds requested from the Foundation in subsequent years as long as it does not exceed the annual maximum of \$25,000.

What are typical reasons an application is declined? The most common reasons an application is declined are: (1) an organization does not meet the eligibility requirements; (2) the application is incomplete; (3) the organization is not financially stable; (4) there is no indication from the application that a general operating grant would strengthen the organization or help maximize its service delivery.

Who will evaluate the applications?

Each application will be evaluated on its own merits and will be reviewed by the Foundation's staff and Board of Directors.

What are the reporting requirements?

General operating grant recipients are required to annually submit a written report along with an up to date application cover sheet and financial statements.

What if my application is denied? If your application is denied, you may reapply for general operating support after six months.
