"ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION" OF

O'KEEFE EDUCATIONAL MEDIA (OEM) dba DISABILITY CONNECTION (FORMERLY)

O'Keefe Educational Media Group & Destination & Educational Videos Original Approval- February 2002 (Revisions- March 8, 2010, December 1, 201, April 2013) (Final Revision- April 2014)

ARTICLE I (Name and Principal Office)

The Undersigned, who are citizens of the United States, desiring to form a nonprofit corporation under Mississippi Statutes hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation

The name of the Corporation is O'Keefe Educational Media, doing business as Disability Connection. The office is located AT 700 Pass Rd, Gulfport, MS 39501 in Harrison County.

ARTICLE II (Purpose)

The Corporation is organized and at all times shall be operated exclusively for charitable and educational purposes, including, but not only for such purposes under section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code:

Mission Statement: "Creating a Connected Community: to inform, assist, and participate in collaborations that engage individuals with disabilities to fully participate in their community, eliminating barriers, and fostering cooperation and understanding."

Solely for the above purposes, the Corporation is empowered to exercise all rights and powers conferred by the laws of the State of Mississippi upon nonprofit corporations organized for charitable and educational purposes including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code. All funds, whether income or principal, and whether acquired by gift or contribution or otherwise, shall be devoted for the above said purposes

ARTICLE III (Exemption Requirements)

At all times shall the following operate as conditions restricting the operations and activities of the Corporation:

(1) No part of the net earnings of the organization shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the organization shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purpose set forth in the purpose clause hereof.

- (2) The majority of the Board of Directors will be non-salaried and will not be related to salaried personnel or to parties providing services. The salaried individuals cannot vote on their own propaganda or otherwise attempt to influence legislation, or any initiative or referendum compensation and those compensation decisions will be made by the board.
- (3) No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall constitute the carrying on before the public, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including by publication of distribution of statements), any political campaign on behalf of, or in opposition to, any candidate for public office
- (4) Notwithstanding any other provisions of this document, the organization shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by an organization exempt from federal income tax under section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by an organization, contributions to which are deductible under section 170 (c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future tax code.

ARTICLE IV (Duration)

The Duration of the corporate existence shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE V (Board of Directors)

The Corporation shall have no members. The management of the affairs of the Corporation shall be vested in a Board of Directors, as defined in the Corporation's bylaws No Director shall have the right, title, or interest in or to any property of the Corporation.

Members of the Board of Directors shall serve for 3 years and are eligible for re-election, or removed as provided in the Bylaws ARTICLE III, Section 7, and board positions are retained following the three years until the next yearly board meeting vote. After two consecutive 3 year terms, Executive Board members must be removed for one year before serving a third term, but may serve in an advisory capacity. (Due to a 1 ½ year lapse in business from Aug 2005-March 2007, due to Hurricane Katrina, board positions all began March of 2007 when the company officially had the first board meeting.)

ARTICLE VI (Personal Liability)

No (member) officer, or Director of this corporation shall be personally liable for the debts or obligations of this corporation of any nature whatsoever, nor shall any of the property of the (members) officer, or Directors be subject to the payment of the debts or obligations of this corporation.

ARTICLE VII

(Copyrights and Sales)

All copyrights of films/materials produced by O'Keefe Educational Media (and/or under the name of Disability Connection or Destination & Educational Videos) will be held by O'Keefe Educational Media. Copyrights may be shared with the film producer/designer if applicable.

Products that were copyrighted under the name Destination & Educational Videos have been transferred to and will be held by O'Keefe Educational Media, also known as Disability Connection. OEM may consider the distribution of previously produced materials that hold existing copyrights or have no copyrights. In such case only the purchase and distribution of films or material from previously produced films will be considered at minimum cost in order to distribute materials. Therefore no monies would be raised for the production of said films. Sales of films/materials will be handled solely through OEM without royalties paid- with the exception, and when necessary in special circumstances which may be individually contracted with an artist or individual who are the subject being highlighted.

ARTICLE VIII (Dissolution)

Upon the dissolution of the organization, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not disposed of by the District Court of the county in which the principal office of the organization is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said court shall determine which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

"BYLAWS" OF

O'KEEFE EDUCATIONAL MEDIA, (dba) DISABILITY CONNECTION

ARTICLE 1 (Name and Purpose)

Section 1: The name of this corporation shall be O'Keefe Educational Media, dba Disability Connection. Its mailing address will be 700 Pass Rd, Gulfport, MS 39501 in Harrison County. The Board of Directors may change the principal office from one location to another. The secretary on these bylaws opposite this Section shall note any change of location of the principal office, or this Section will be amended to state the new location.

Section 2: The Board of Directors may at any time establish branch or subordinate offices at any places where the corporation is qualified to conduct its activities.

Section 3: OEM is organized exclusively for charitable and educational purposes, more specifically the mission is "Creating a Connected Community: to inform, assist, and participate in collaborations that <u>engage individuals with disabilities</u> to fully participate in their community, eliminating barriers, and fostering cooperation and understanding."

Products will be made available to students through school libraries, the public through public libraries and internet, and through other nonprofit organizations promoting education and public information to businesses, municipals and agencies. OEM will never discriminate because of age, income, race, or disability.

ARTICLE II (Membership)

Section 1: The Corporation shall have no members. The management of the affairs of the Corporation shall be vested in a Board of Directors.

ARTICLE III

(Board of Directors)

Section 1: The Board shall have up to twelve (12) Voting Directors but no less than three (3) Voting Directors. Each director shall serve up to three (3) years, but are eligible for re-election to an additional 3 years. The Board shall receive no compensation.

Section 2: The Board is responsible for overall policy and direction of the Corporation and shall delegate responsibility for day-to-day operations to the President and/or Chief Executive Officer.

Section 3: The Board shall meet a minimum of twice a year for an Executive meeting at an agreed upon time and place. Special meetings may be called by the President or by written request of a majority of the Directors. Meetings of the Board of Directors, regular or special, may be held with no less than one (1) week notice to each Director contacted personally, or by e-mail, mail or telephone. Any meeting may be held by conference telephone or similar communication equipment, as long as all Directors participating in the meeting can hear one another. For polling members to make business decisions or vote on individual issues, electronic communication (e-mail) can be used and those responding will be considered attending the meeting. All such Directors participating shall be deemed to be present in person at such a meeting.

Section 7: Any officer elected or appointed by the Board of Directors may be removed at any time with or without cause by the affirmative vote of two thirds of the Directors in Office with the exception of the Chief Executive Director who can only be removed according to Section 6 part (b). Any vacancy occurring in any office of the corporation shall be filled by the Board of Directors no sooner than thirty days after written notice of the vacancy has been mailed (or e-mailed) to all members. Any Officer may resign at any time by giving written notice to the Corporation and said notice shall take effect as of the date the notice is received. An Officer may be dropped for more than one (1) unexcused absence from Board meetings in one year by the Board of Directors. An Officer of the Board of Directors may also be removed for other reasons by a two-thirds vote of the remaining Directors.

Section 8: The Board of Directors may create committees as needed, such as fund raising, etc

ARTICLE IV (Fiscal Year)

Section 1: The Corporation's Fiscal Year shall begin on the first day of January and end on the last day of December in each year.

ARTICLE V (Corporate Seal)

Section 1. The Corporate Seal shall be circular in form and shall have the name of the Corporation inscribed thereon with the date of its incorporation and the word "Mississippi"

ARTICLE VI (Corporate Logo)

The Corporate name, logo and membership list are reserved for use by the Corporation and shall not be used for any purpose unless written permission has been granted by the Board of Directors.

ARTICLE VII (Contracts, Check, Deposits, and Funds)

Section 1 Except as the Board of Directors may generally or in particular cases authorize the execution thereof in some other manner, all checks, drafts and other instruments for the payment of money and all instruments of transfer of securities shall be signed in the name and on behalf of the Corporation by the President and Chief Executive Officer or by other Officers, Agents, or Employees of the Corporation as may from time to time be designated by the Board of Directors. All instruments of transfer of real property and all contracts and agreements shall be signed by such Officers or Agents as the Board of Directors shall direct. The Board of Directors may authorize and empower one or more Officers or Agents of the Corporation to execute and deliver any and all papers and documents or to do other acts or things on behalf of the Corporation, including any required or convenient in dealing with Government Authorities.

Section 2: All funds of the Corporation shall be deposited from time to time to the credit of the Corporation in such banks, trust companies or other depositories as the Board of Directors may select.

Section 3: The Board of Directors may accept on behalf of the Corporation any contribution, gift, bequest, or devise for the general purposes or for any special purpose of the Corporation.

ARTICLE VIII (Advisory Board)

Section 1: The Corporation may authorize the establishment of an Advisory Board to help advise the Corporation. The Advisory Board shall not be limited in size, but board members do not have voting rights. The Board of Directors shall not vote on Members to serve on the Advisory Board, but any Member can be refused a position on the Advisory Board by the request of only one Executive Board member or any Director of OEM with reasonable cause. The Advisory Board will continue meeting until the Executive Board deems that their need has expired in advisement for the project that they were selected to serve. The Advisory Board shall receive no compensation and members may resign or be removed under the rules governing the Board of Directors in ARTICLE III Section 7. The Advisory Board will not be expected to attend meetings of the Executive Board of Directors.

ARTICLE IX (Maintenance and Inspection of Articles and Bylaws)

Section 1: The Corporation shall keep at its principal office the original copy of the Articles of Incorporation and Bylaws, as amended to date. Every Director shall have the absolute right at any reasonable time to inspect the Corporation's books, records, documents of every kind and the records of each of its subsidiaries.

Section 2: The Board of Directors shall cause an annual report to be sent to the Directors within 120 days after the end of the Corporations Fiscal Year listing assets, and liabilities, revenue, expenses, or disbursements of the corporation for both general and restricted purposes. These requirements of an annual report shall not apply if the Corporation receives less than \$25,000 in gross receipts during any one fiscal year.

ARTICLE X (Dissolution)

In the event that the Corporation is dissolved by the action of the majority of its Board of Directors or by an Act of Law, any and all funds held at the time of such dissolution shall be donated to another nonprofit corporation at the discretion of the Board of Directors.

ARTICLE XI (Amendments)

Section1: These Bylaws may be altered, amended or repealed and new Bylaws may be adopted by a majority of Directors in Office at any regular or special meeting, provided that no such action shall be taken if it would in any way adversely affect the Corporation's qualification under Section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or any successor provision).
