

BOARD OF DIRECTORS MATCHING GIFT PROGRAM

Purpose: The Board of Directors Matching Gift Program is established to provide support to charitable organizations deemed important to Brunswick's Board of Directors. This program offers a way of combining personal contributions of the Directors with those of the Brunswick Foundation, thereby creating the ability to contribute substantially more to organizations of particular interest.

Eligibility: The donor must be a current member of the Board of Directors of Brunswick Corporation. Eligible organizations must be non-profit and granted exemption under section 501(c)(3) and ruled to be publicly supported under section 509(a) of the Internal Revenue Code.

Type of Gift to be Matched: The Foundation will only match cash gifts personally donated (not merely pledged) by the director. The cash distribution must be in check form from their individual/trust account only. Stock donations cannot be matched until the shares are sold and the cash value is received by the 501(c)(3) organization. There are no exceptions to this rule.

Organizations Eligible for Matching Gifts: Gifts will be limited to non-profit, tax-exempt organizations focused within four major subject areas:

1. **Youth & Family:** Organizations whose primary purpose is the support of youth or family concerns: scouting programs, youth leadership, day care organizations, recreational programs, youth clubs, family crisis and counseling centers, or community shelters.
2. **Arts & Culture:** Art, science, or history museums, libraries, professional and community orchestras, theaters, dance groups, public television and radio, zoos, botanical gardens, and archeological or historical societies.
3. **Education:** Accredited public and independent primary and secondary education programs, accredited four-year colleges and universities, graduate and professional schools, junior and community colleges, special schools for the mentally and physically handicapped; tax-exempt college funds, foundations, or associations whose purpose is to transmit funds to an institution described above; eligible educational institutions operated by religious or fraternal organizations, if their services are offered to the general public.
4. **Health:** Other tax-exempt organizations not described above that add to the quality of life (i.e. disease awareness, medical research, hospitals, etc.)

Amount of Contributions: The Foundation will match up to a maximum of \$5,000 contributed per director per a program year (December 1 – November 30). In order for the contribution to be accounted for in the current year, the Foundation must receive this form by December 20; if received after this date it will be accounted for in the following year. The minimum individual gift to be matched by the Foundation is \$1,000.

Restrictions: Matching contributions *will not* be made to the following types of organizations: United Way campaigns, fraternal, social, political, union or veteran organizations; specific churches or religious groups; government agencies; or organizations that limit their services to one religious group; athletic organizations; dues to national or local alumni groups. In addition, bequests or gifts of property or payment in exchange for services rendered (e.g. tickets, memberships, tuition, subscriptions, advertising or dinners) will not be allowed.





For more than 50 years, The Brunswick Foundation has supported causes and programs that complement the business interests of Brunswick Corporation and enhance the interests of the Company's employees and the communities in which they live and work. One such program is the Sons & Daughters Scholarship Program. We are pleased that you are going to attend a university and have decided to apply for a Brunswick Foundation Sons & Daughters Scholarship. Detailed below are the scholarship program guidelines, as well as the scholarship application process.

AWARDS AND ELIGIBILITY

Students applying for this scholarship program are eligible for a single-year scholarship of up to \$2,500 (with a maximum of up to \$10,000 per recipient).

Eligible applicants must be 23 years of age or younger (exception for military duty) as of February 28, 2013, and are students:

- currently in the final year of high school/secondary school;
- with a grade point average of 2.0 or higher on a 4.0 scale;
- who are entering full-time to an accredited, nonprofit college, university or vocational school by the Fall of 2013;
- whose parent, stepparent or guardian is employed as a full-time employee of Brunswick Corporation, or one of its divisions/subsidiaries on February 28, 2013 and who has worked for Brunswick for at least one year of continuous service in the previous five years. Employees and spouses of employees are not eligible to apply.

SELECTION OF RECIPIENTS

Selections are made by an impartial, outside committee comprised of professionals from prominent universities. No representatives of Brunswick Corporation or The Brunswick Foundation are involved in the selection process.

No preference is accorded to an applicant by reason of a parent's position or length of employment.
