Continue our program to assist Military families, who have a spouse serving in active duty, with home repairs such as water heaters/furnaces/air conditioners/pipes or other plumbing, roofs, carpentry, electrical issues or other items necessary to be repaired. Assisted 12 families in 2013.

Held a fundraiser to raise funds to help with repairs to our aging Labor Temple.
