- SEC. 1. FISCAL YEAR. The fiscal year of the Company shall end on the 31st day of December in each year.
- SEC. 2. CORPORATE SEAL. The Board of Directors shall provide a suitable corporate seal, which seal shall be in charge of the Secretary, and shall be used by him.

#### ARTICLE II

#### **DIRECTORS**

#### ARTICLE III

#### **OFFICERS**

- SEC. 1. The Board of Directors shall select a President, a Secretary and a Treasurer and may select one or more Vice-Presidents, Assistant Secretaries and Assistant Treasurers, who shall be elected by the Board of Directors at their regular annual meeting. The term of office shall be for one year and until their successors are chosen. No one of such officers, except the President, need be a director, but a Vice-President who is not a director, cannot succeed to or fill the office of President. Any two of the above offices, except those of President and Vice-President, may be held by the same person, but no officer shall execute, acknowledge, or verify any instrument in more than one capacity.
- SEC. 2. The Board of Directors may also appoint such other officers and agents as they may deem necessary for the transaction of the business of the Corporation. All officers and agents shall respectively have such authority and perform such duties in the management of the property and affairs of the Corporation as may be designated by the Board of Directors. Without limitation of any right of an officer or agent to recover damages for breach of contract, the Board of Directors may remove any officer or agent whenever, in their judgment, the business interests of the Corporation will be served thereby.

#### ARTICLE IV

#### DUTIES OF OFFICERS

- SEC. 1. PRESIDENT. The President shall be the chief executive officer of the Company, and in the recess of the Board of Directors shall have the general control and management of its business and affairs, subject, however, to the right of the Board of Directors to delegate any specific power except such as may be by statute exclusively conferred upon the President, to any other officer or officers of the Company. He shall preside at all meetings of the Directors.
- SEC. 2. VICE-PRESIDENT. In case the office of President shall become vacant by death, resignation, or otherwise, or in case of the absence of the President, or his disability to discharge the duties of his office, such duties shall, for the time being, devolve upon the Vice-President who shall do and perform such other acts as the Board of Directors may, from time to time, authorize him to do, but a Vice-President who is not a director cannot succeed to or fill the office of President.
- SEC. 3. TREASURER. The Treasurer shall have custody and keep account of all money, funds and property of the Company, unless otherwise determined by the Board of Directors, and he shall render such accounts and present such statement to the Directors and President as may be required of him. He shall deposit all funds of the Company which may come into his hands in such bank or banks as the Board of Directors may designate. He shall keep his bank accounts in the name of the

Company, and shall exhibit his books and accounts, at all reasonable times, to any Director of the Company upon application at the office of the Company during business hours. He shall pay out money as the business may require upon the order of the properly constituted officer or officers of the Company, taking proper vouchers therefor; provided, however, that the Board of Directors shall have power by resolution to delegate any of the duties of the Treasurer to other officers, and to provide by what officers, if any, all bills, notes, checks, vouchers, orders or other instruments shall be countersigned. He shall perform, in addition, such other duties as may be delegated to him by the Board of Directors.

SEC. 4. SECRETARY. The Secretary of the Company shall keep the minutes of all the meetings of the Board of Directors in books provided for that purpose; he shall attend to the giving and receiving of all notices of the Company; he shall sign, with the President or Vice-President, in the name of the Company, all contracts authorized by the Board of Directors, and when necessary shall affix the corporate seal of the Company thereto; he shall have charge of such other books and papers as the Board of Directors may direct; all of which, shall, at all reasonable times, be open to the examination of any Director upon application at the office of Secretary, and in addition such other duties as may be delegated to him by the Board of Directors.

#### ARTICLE V

#### **AMENDMENTS**

SEC. 1. The Board of Directors may alter, amend, add to or repeal these By-Laws, including the fixing and altering of the Board of Directors; provided that the Board of Directors shall not make or alter any By-Laws fixing their qualifications, classifications, or term of office.
