SUMMARY OF PROGRAM-RELATED INVESTMENTS:

Grand Action Foundation

The Dick and Betsy DeVos Family Foundation ("Foundation") has made a loan to Grand Action Foundation to provide funds to assist in the construction costs of the Grand Rapids Downtown Market (the "Market"). The interest rate of the loan is one (1%) percent.

A promissory note of \$3,500,000 was executed on July 12, 2013. A partial forgiveness of the note was granted in the amount of \$500,000 on December 9, 2013. The outstanding balance of the note including accrued interest as of December 31, 2013 was \$3,011,555.

The construction of the Market will provide community benefits including economic revitalization, job creation, and providing healthy good access to vulnerable children and families. The loan provides Grand Action Foundation the funds it needs to make a loan to assist with the construction costs of the Market.

Grand Action Foundation is a public charity focused on identifying building and revitalization projects in downtown Grand Rapids, supporting these projects, and assisting with the funding strategies for each project.

SUMMARY OF PROGRAM-RELATED INVESTMENTS:

Outdoor Discovery Center Macatawa Greenway

The Dick and Betsy DeVos Family Foundation ("Foundation") has made a no-interest loan to the Outdoor Discovery Center Macatawa Greenway (ODCMG) to provide funds to assist with "Project Clarity".

A promissory note of \$400,000 was executed on August 26, 2013. In 2013 the ODCMG borrowed \$375,000 in August and repaid \$50,000 in October. The outstanding balance of the note as of December 31, 2013 was \$325,000.

The purpose of Project Clarity is to remediate the water quality issues of Lake Macatawa and the Macatawa Watershed. This multi-phased approach provides solutions focused on land restoration, Best Management Practices (BMPs), community education, and long term sustainability. The advantage of this phased approach is that each phase builds on its predecessor, thereby avoiding redundancy and providing flexibility in implementation. The project includes solutions that address the problems of Lake Macatawa both at the source (passive wetland restoration) and further downstream.

ArtPrize Grand Rapids

The Dick and Betsy DeVos Family Foundation ("Foundation") has made a no-interest loan to ArtPrize Grand Rapids to provide funds to assist in the organization and operations of the 2013 ArtPrize competition and exhibition in Grand Rapids, Michigan in September and October 2013.

A promissory note of \$5,000,000 has been executed between the Foundation and ArtPrize. The balance of the note on January 1, 2013 was \$3,806,705. In 2013, Artprize borrowed \$200,000 on this promissory note and a partial forgiveness of the note was granted in the amount of \$1,492,836. This amount was commensurate with the challenge grant issued by the Foundation to incentivize new and returning contributors to Artprize. The outstanding balance of the note as of December 31, 2013 was \$2,513,869.

The ArtPrize competition and exhibition is a radically open international art competition which awards the world's largest art prizes. It is considered to be part arts festival and part social experiment and creates an environment where people are inspired to go from imagining to making and doing. Its mission begins with the value that art is important. From that statement the ArtPrize competition and exhibition seeks to be a catalyst for collisions and connections between artists and communities for the sake of infusing vitality and courage into culture.
