Outdoor Discovery Center Macatawa Greenway

The Dick and Betsy DeVos Family Foundation ("Foundation") has made a no-interest loan to the Outdoor Discovery Center Macatawa Greenway (ODCMG) to provide funds to assist with "Project Clarity".

A promissory note of \$400,000 was executed on August 26, 2013. In 2013 the ODCMG borrowed \$375,000 in August and repaid \$50,000 in October. The outstanding balance of the note as of December 31, 2013 was \$325,000.

The purpose of Project Clarity is to remediate the water quality issues of Lake Macatawa and the Macatawa Watershed. ArtPrize Grand Rapids

The Dick and Betsy DeVos Family Foundation ("Foundation") has made a no-interest loan to ArtPrize Grand Rapids to provide funds to assist in the organization and operations of the 2013 ArtPrize competition and exhibition in Grand Rapids, Michigan in September and October 2013.

A promissory note of \$5,000,000 has been executed between the Foundation and ArtPrize. The balance of the note on January 1, 2013 was \$3,806,705. In 2013, Artprize borrowed \$200,000 on this promissory note and a partial forgiveness of the note was granted in the amount of \$1,492,836.
