Summary of organizations supported

Adoni Roi Congregation & Dugit Ministry / Tel Aviv: Avi Mizrachi is the Director of Dugit Street Ministry and Senior pastor, Adonai Roi, in Tel Aviv. The Congregation serves the greater Tel Aviv area and the Dugit Ministry is located downtown and opens daily as a free coffee center and book distributor, witnessing to visitors.

KAM Jerusalem Witness to the Jewish people: Victor Smadja, is a superb Bible scholar dedicated to teaching and witness to the Jewish people. KAM prints, binds and distributes books & literature "free" to the Jewish people throughout Israel. Victor is also the Senior Pastor of Jerusalem Assembly, a Messianic congregation in Jerusalem.

Bethlehem Bible College: Dr Bishara Awad, President Emeritus, Bethlehem Bible College, Alex Awad, Dean, & the administrative staff at Bethlehem Bible College established BBC in 1979 has grown to be a major Christian Institution in Palestine. Part of the College is a library open to the general public and is the only library in Bethlehem.

Shepherds Society Bethlehem BBC: Shepherds Society oversees the Families program that CWP provides support for Christian families at \$50 monthly since 1997. Administrator George Abad and Pastor Alex Awad oversee the Shepherds Society at BBC which meets a vital need in the Bethlehem community. It currently serves 75 to 100 families annually.

Beit Asaph Congregation Natanya: Evan Thomas, Senior Pastor Beit Asaph leads this Messianic Congregation in Netanya Israel. Evan is very active in evangelism and outreach to the Jewish people. Evan is on the Board of Musalaha, a reconciliation Ministry in Jerusalem, dedicated to teaching peace and understanding between Jews and Arabs. CWP is designated by Beit Asaph as the USA agent to receive gifts "designated" for the Netanya ministry.

Safford's Children Center Old City Jerusalem: The children's center is located inside the Old City near the Damascus Gate. Dr Dajani is Director & Chief Operations Officer for Spafford. They provide a broad range of services to children and their families. Their needs are great and CWP has been providing support for the children's programs since 1997.

Crèche Holy Family Home Bethlehem: The Sisters of Charity provide care for an average of 90 to 100 children in a well maintained and pristine environment. I have visited many times and I am always impressed with the clean environment and loving patience provided by the staff to the children. It is a much needed calling by special people who help orphaned children, and children of poor families, who are unable to provide for their needs.

Church of the Nazarene, Nazareth: Nizar Touma, Pastor, and his wife Katy, lead this congregation located in downtown Nazareth that also has a very large daycare program which serves many secular and Muslim families in the region. Nizar is a leader in evangelism in Israel and Palestine serving as a speaker and advisor to other ministries.

Joplin Tornado Victims Fund; CWP and First Baptist Church Joplin formed a partnership to provide assistance to the families who suffered losses in the 2011 Tornado in Joplin. Over 30 families have been assisted with gifts ranging from \$1,000 to \$2,000 per family depending on family size and need. The program is administered by the FBC and continued into 2013. When the program finished serving all referred victims of the Tornado, the remaining balance in the fund was redirected to other mission projects. One of the projects receiving funds was the Oasis Senior Facility which will provide for long term needs of seniors in the Joplin area, including many affected by the tornado.

Oasis Seniors Center Joplin: In 2012, Oasis founder Jon Lowry convened the first board of directors, and later that year, Oasis purchased nearly 15 acres of land with a four-bedroom home just south of McClelland Park in Joplin. In 2013, Oasis received a grant from the Community Foundation of Southwest Missouri as well as a low-interest rate loan from the Joplin Tomorrow Fund. Many of the victims of the devastating tornado that hit Joplin in 2011 were Seniors, who are still recovering from the loss of home, furnishings and personal affects. Oasis wants to provide housing and assistance to as many of these affected Seniors as possible.
