Even with the best of skills we sometimes need help with conflict, and GCC works both to provide that help and to train others in taking the "third side" as interested community members. This is the second way that we work to increase the potential for peace. Through restorative processes

we create a safe space and give all sides of a conflict a chance to speak

and be heard. This work can happen anywhere that we find ourselves in community. It is used in schools, courts, shelters, intentional communities, neighborhoods and many other places.

In all of our work we strive to cultivate curiosity about communication and a positive orientation to conflict. This lets us look at conflict as both feedback from the systems we are in and also as an opportunity to improve our relationships in a way that doesn't compromise our own needs. Many

of us are either avoidant or aggressive, but with a little training and support we can

develop strategies that utilize compromise and collaboration. None of us has to be stuck with the ways we currently meet conflict. At GCC our motto is, "Conflict is Inevitable, Violence is Not."
