The Foundation worked collaboratively with select grantees in 2013 to modify their grant agreements to clarify the conditional nature of the grants, specifically the monitoring and due diligence process. While the Foundation remains in partnership with our grantees, based on generally accepted accounting principles, the grant agreement modifications mean these grants will be recorded on the financial statements when the conditions are satisfied, rather than recorded as liabilities. This results in a decrease in grants payable of \$86,659,709 and an increase in other income.
