The undersigned incorporator(s), in order to form a non-profit corporation under the laws of the state of Texas, adopt the following amended Articles of Incorporation:

1. This corporation is formed pursuant to the Texas Business Organization Code, Title 2, Sections 22.001 et seq.
2. The name of the corporation is GFT Charity, Inc.
3. The corporation shall not issue shares of stock.
4. The corporation shall have no members.
5. The period of duration of this corporation is perpetual.
6. The corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, and educational purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.
7. No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in paragraph (6) above. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.
8. Upon the dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the county in which

the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations said Court shall determine, such are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

9. Directors of the corporation shall be elected annually, for one-year terms, by majority vote of the Board of Directors of the corporation, including those directors whose terms are at that time expiring.
10. The street address of the corporation's registered office is 412 Robin Road located in the city of Cedar Hill, 75104.
11. The name of the corporation's registered agent, who is located at the above registered office, is Lilli L. Gober. Said registered agent is a resident of Texas.
12. To the fullest extent permitted by law, liability of officers and directors of the corporation is eliminated, pursuant to Texas Business Organization Code, Title 2, Section 22.235.


