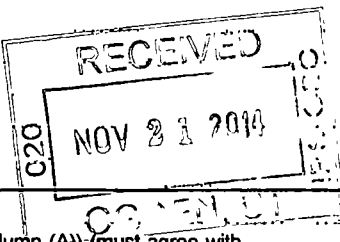

It Is Hereby Certified That:

The undersigned, a natural person of the age of eighteen years or over acting as the incorporator of a corporation pursuant to the New York Not-for-Profit Corporation Law, hereby adopts the following certificate for this corporation:

1. The name corporation is: **GLOBAL PROJECT HOPE INC.**
2. The corporation is a corporation as defined in subparagraph (a) (5) of Section 102 of the Not-For Profit Corporation Law.
3. The Corporation is a Type **B** Corporation as defined in Section 201 of the Not-for-Profit Corporation Law.
4. The purposes for which the corporation is formed are:

Global Project Hope is a nonprofit company that aims to help those areas deprived of proper educational opportunities. Within the local community, Global Project Hope will take on fundraising activities and collecting monetary donations and school supplies to send directly to those who will use these resources to develop their educational institutions. Donations will be collected through online web-site donations. We pursue this initiative in order to end worldwide poverty and to encourage students to reach their highest potentials.

To accept, hold, invest, reinvest & administer any gifts, bequests, devises, benefits of trust (but not to act as trustee of any trust) and property of any sort, without limitation as to amount of value, and to use, disburse or donate the income or principal thereof for exclusively charitable purposes.

To give, convey or assign any of its property outright, or upon lawful terms regarding the use thereof, to other organizations, provided that: (i) such organizations shall be organized and operated exclusively for religious, charitable, scientific, literary, or educational purposes, or for the prevention of cruelty to children or animals; (ii) transfers of property to such organizations shall, to the extent then permitted under the statutes of the United States government, be exempt from gift, succession, inheritance, estate or death taxes (by whatever name called) imposed by the United States Government; and (iii) such organizations shall, to the extent then permitted under the statutes of the United States Government, be exempt from income taxes imposed by the United States Government.

Nothing herein shall authorize the Corporation, directly or indirectly, to engage in or include among its purposes any of the activities mentioned in Not-for-Profit Corporation Law Section 404 (a) through (c) and (e) through (v).

Nothing herein shall authorize the corporation to operate, maintain or manage a charter school, a nursery school, an elementary school, a secondary school, a college, university or to advertise or offer credit-bearing courses or degrees in New York State.

Nothing herein shall authorize the corporation to operate or maintain a library, museum, archive or historical society or to own or hold collections.

Except as authorized by Title VIII or other applicable statute, nothing herein shall authorize the corporation to engage in the practice of any profession in New York, engage in the training of any profession in New York or to use a professional title or term of any profession in New York in violation of Title VIII of the Education Law.

To do any other act or thing incidental to or connected with the foregoing purposes or in advancement thereof, but not for the pecuniary profit or financial gain of its members, directors or officers, except as permitted under Article 5 of the Not-for-Profit Corporation Law.

In furtherance of its corporate purposes, the Corporation shall have all general powers enumerated in Section 202 of the Not-for-Profit Corporation Law, together with the powers to solicit grants and contributions for corporate purposes.

5. The following language relates to the corporations tax exempt status and is not a statement of purposes and powers. Notwithstanding any other provision of this certificate of incorporation, the organization is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended or corresponding provisions of any subsequent federal tax laws (the "Internal Revenue Code") and shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by (a) a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code.
6. No part of the net earnings of the organization shall inure to the benefit of or be distributable to, any member, trustee, director, or officer of the Corporation or any other private person or entity, except that the Corporation shall be authorized to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distribution in furtherance of its purposes as set forth in this certificate of incorporation.
7. No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall be carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation (except as otherwise provided by Internal Revenue Code Section 501(h)), and the Corporation shall not participate or intervene in

(including the publication or distributions of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.

8. In the event of dissolution, all of the remaining assets and property of the Corporation shall after payment of necessary expenses and satisfaction of all liabilities thereof be distributed upon approval of a Justice of the Supreme Court of the State of New York to another organization exempt under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue code or to the Federal government, or state or local government for a public purpose.
9. In any taxable year in which the Corporation is a private foundation as described in Section 509(a) of the Internal Revenue Code, the Corporation shall distribute its income for said period at such time and in such manner as not to subject it to tax under Section 4942 of the Internal Revenue Code; and the Corporation shall not (a) engage in any act of self-dealing as defined in Section 4941(d) of the Internal Revenue Code, (b) retain any excess business holdings as defined in Section 4943(c) of the Internal Revenue Code, (c) make any investments in such a manner as to subject the corporation to tax under Section 4944 of the Internal Revenue Code, or (d) make any taxable expenditures as defined in Section 4945(d) of the Internal Revenue Code.
10. The organization shall, to the fullest extent permitted by Article 7 of the Not-For-Profit Corporation Law of the State of New York, as the same may be amended and supplemented, indemnify any and all persons whom it shall have the power to indemnify under said Article from an against any and all of the expenses, liabilities or other matters referred to in or covered by said Article, and the indemnification provided for herein shall not be deemed exclusive of any other right to which a person may be entitled under any By-Law, resolution or directors, agreement, or otherwise, as permitted by said Article, as to action in any capacity in which a person served at the request of the organization.
11. The personal liability of the directors of the organization is hereby eliminated to the fullest extent permitted by the provisions of Section 719, Section 720 and Section 720(a) of the Not-For-Profit Law.
12. The office of the corporation in the State of New York shall be located in the County of **Nassau**.
13. The Corporation shall be operated by a board of directors, the number of which it to be no less than three.

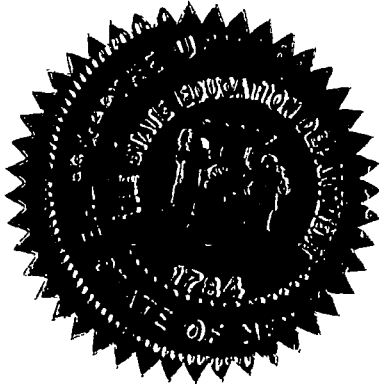
