An act relating to specialty license plates; amending ss. 320.08056 and 320.08058, F.S.; creating the Stop Heart Disease license plate; providing for distribution to the Florida Heart Research Foundation, Inc., of annual use fees received from the sale of such plates; providing an effective date.

WHEREAS, heart disease is the leading cause of death and disability in this country and in the State of Florida, claiming the lives of more than 2,600 Americans every day, an average of one death every 33 seconds, and cardiovascular disease accounts for over 40 percent of all deaths, claiming more lives each year than the next seven leading causes of death combined, and

WHEREAS, more than 61 million Americans suffer from cardiovascular disease, including high blood pressure, coronary heart disease, stroke, congestive heart failure, and other conditions, and

WHEREAS, 25 percent of males and 38 percent of females who experience a heart attack die within 1 year, and

WHEREAS, 50 percent of men and 63 percent of women who die of sudden cardiac death experience no previous symptoms of coronary heart disease, and

WHEREAS, cardiovascular disease takes an astonishing toll on the economy through health care costs, lost work days, and lowered productivity, which costs are estimated to reach \$330 billion in 2002, and

WHEREAS, almost 20 percent of all Social Security disability payments are made to disabled Americans with heart disease, and

WHEREAS, men and women are at equal risk for cardiovascular disease and are also affected as husbands, wives, fathers, mothers, brothers, sisters, children, and friends of people suffering from cardiovascular disease, and

WHEREAS, in Florida, there will be over 65,000 deaths per year from cardiovascular disease, and hospitalization costs to care for Floridians with cardiovascular disease will top \$4.4 billion per year, and

WHEREAS, the only hope of ending this disease is through research aimed at discovering its cause, its cure, and, most importantly, its prevention, and

WHEREAS, the Florida Heart Research Foundation, Inc., was developed for cardiovascular research, education, and prevention programs throughout the State of Florida, NOW, THEREFORE,

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Paragraph (mm) is added to subsection (4) of section 320.08056, Florida Statutes, to read:

320.08056 Specialty license plates.--

(4) The following license plate annual use fees shall be collected for the appropriate specialty license plates:

(mm) Stop Heart Disease license plate, \$25.

Section 2. Subsection (39) is added to section 320.08058, Florida Statutes, to read:

- 320.08058 Specialty license plates.--
- (39) STOP HEART DISEASE LICENSE PLATES. --
- (a) The department shall develop a Stop Heart Disease license plate as provided in this section. Stop Heart Disease license plates must bear the colors and design approved by the department. The plate shall be designed to include a red, white, and blue background with a slanted heart shape in the middle of the plate. The word "Florida" shall appear at the top of the plate in yellow outlined in black, and the words "Stop Heart Disease" shall appear at the bottom of the plate in yellow.
- (b) The department shall remit the proceeds of the annual use fee to the Florida Heart Research Foundation, Inc. The first \$80,000 of the use fee given to the Florida Heart Research Foundation, Inc., shall be used to pay startup costs, including costs incurred developing and issuing the plates. Thereafter, the Florida Heart Research Foundation, Inc., shall provide for a peer review grant solicitation and award process to distribute fees for cardiovascular disease research, education, and prevention within the state and shall make the funds available for any one or more of the following:
- 1. Quality research to pursue top quality cardiovascular research that will further understanding of heart disease and its cause, treatment, cure, and prevention. Accepted projects must conform to the highest standards of scientific research, be efficiently organized, and report updates continually to ensure research credibility and excellence.
- 2. Heart disease prevention programs to provide cardiovascular screenings to state residents.

- 3. Educational programs to offer educational programs, literature, seminars, or speakers for both clinicians and lay people so that the latest risk factors, technologies, treatments, methodologies, protocols, and preventive measures are well known and used in the state.
- (c) In the first year in which the plate is issued, no more than 25 percent of the fees collected may be used for administrative costs directly associated with the operation of the Florida Heart Research Foundation, Inc., and marketing and promotion of the Stop Heart Disease license plate. In the second and subsequent years in which the plate is sold, no more than 20 percent of the fees collected may be used for administrative costs directly associated with the operation of the Florida Heart Research Foundation, Inc., and marketing and promotion of the Stop Heart Disease license plate.

Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2003.





2012 Stop Heart Disease Specialty License Plate Summary From the Florida Heart Research Foundation

The Stop Heart Disease specialty license plate was enacted on July 1, 2003 by the Florida State Legislature. \$25 from each plate sold or renewed goes to the Florida Heart Research Foundation (FHRF) and is legislatively mandated to go toward heart disease research, education and prevention programs in Florida. FHRF is permitted to allocate 20% of the funds raised toward administration and marketing of the plate. FHRF is a wholly owned subsidiary of the Florida Heart Research Institute – an independent, not-for-profit 501(c)(3) organization with the mission to stop heart disease through research, education and prevention.

2012 marks the ninth year of sales of the **Stop Heart Disease** license plate for the Florida Heart Research Institute. **In the last year, the license plate has sold over 1,043 new plates and over 9,115 renewals raising \$249,425 in total net revenue.**

In 2012 there has been a 13% decrease in sales. Compared to the decrease in sales of other specialty plates, however, the Stop Heart Disease specialty license plate has had the LOWEST rate of decrease of all other specialty plates. We believe this stronghold is due to three key reasons: people are strong supporters of the cause, people love the design, and we consistently devote time into marketing the plate.

In spite of this lag in sales, we are well over the state's minimum requirement of 1,000 sold in one year.

Most of the highly populated counties continue to lead in license plate sales largely due to our marketing efforts (plates sold per county/per month):

- 1. Miami-Dade County
- 2. Broward County
- 3. Palm Beach County
- 4. Hillsborough
- 5. Pinellas

FHRI works closely with the county tax collectors offices across the state in promotion and marketing of the license plate. They recognize the value and importance of the Stop Heart Disease license plate and the Florida Heart Research Institute's mission and have been very supportive of both our cause and our marketing efforts.

Where the Money Goes: License plate revenue is expended on a fiscal year basis from July 1 to June 30. Therefore, from July 1, 2012 to December 31, 2012, the Stop Heart Disease specialty license plate funded the following Research, Education and Prevention programs:

License plate revenue for the period of July 1, 2012 through December 31, 2013 in the amount of \$142,995.49 will be expended in 2013.

The following is a summary of some of our 2012 license plate marketing efforts and achievements:

- ♥ Gubernatorial Proclamation Governor Crist proclaimed the week of February 6 13, 2013 to be Stop Heart Disease Week in order for us to wage a public awareness campaign. Several publications printed the announcement of the proclamation; which highly publicized Florida Heart Research Institute and the work we continue to do.
- ▼ Corporate Outreach Program Through our Corporate Screening and Education Program, we are able to promote the license plate to corporations and organizations throughout South Florida.
- ▼ Stop Heart Disease Researcher of the Year Award This was the seventh award given for cardiovascular research at the annual conference of the Florida Chapter of the American College of Cardiology. This year, the \$25,000 award was given to Dr. Lina Shehadeh, from the University of Miami. She has been awarded this prestigious award for her innovative work on the molecular biology of atherosclerosis
- ▼ Screening Outreach We continue to travel throughout the state to screen Florida residents and simultaneously promote the license plate. Of special interest was the Annual Tax Collector's Conference held in Orlando this year that was attended by over 500 tax collectors and their top managers. Since most motorists purchase their license plates from their local tax collector, this is an extremely important marketing effort because they see firsthand what we do for the general public. In addition, each February we are selected by both Hillsborough and Pinellas County Tax Collectors to do a month long campaign highlighting the Stop Heart Disease License Plate. We provide them with posters, buttons, etc to bring awareness to their patrons so that they can recognize and purchase the plate. In addition, we are also able to provide them with our Educational Awareness Brochures so that they can provide them to their patrons. We also offer a free cardiovascular screening out of their offices during the month of February.
- ▶ Heart Smart Tag Art Award FHRI has partnered with Polk County through the tax collector's office to participate in their Kids Tag Art program. We created the "Heart Smart Tag Art Award" to encourage youth to be mindful of being heart smart by creating a creative Kids Tag Art design. This year three 5th graders were

recognized and honored for their creative "Heart Smart Tag Art" in Polk County at the Polk County Tax collector's office

- ▼ County Promotion- Several counties across the state collaborated with FHRI in the month of February to promote the Stop Heart Disease license plate as well as bring awareness to this cause.
- ✔ Insert Renewal program- this past year we were given permission by approximately 18 counties to include our "PUSHCPR" educational insert that accompanied license plate renewal forms sent to the February birthday renewals. This year we sent close to 400,000 inserts statewide. This year we increased inserts by 100,000 from last year and had 4 additional counties agree to allow the educational inserts compared to 2011. The insert allowed us to provide valuable educational information about the sudden cardiac arrest and learning of PUSHCPR.

Florida State University Researcher Wins Prestigious Cardiology Research Award

Kissimmee, Florida, August 17, 2013—The Florida Heart Research Institute has named Dr. Jose Pinto its eleventh "Stop Heart Disease Researcher of the Year" at the annual meeting of the Florida Chapter of the American College of Cardiology (FCACC) at Disney's Contemporary Hotel in Kissimmee, Florida on Saturday evening. "The future in cardiovascular medicine relies on the highest quality of innovative scientific research," said Kathleen DuCasse, Chief Executive Officer of the Florida Heart Research Institute, in presenting the award.

After receiving his doctorate from the Federal University of Rio de Janeiro, Dr. Pinto applied his knowledge of muscular biochemistry to a fascinating project during his post-doctoral years with the Department of Molecular and Cellular Pharmacology at the University of Miami. Focusing on two genetically-determined but somewhat opposite manifestations of heart disease—hypertrophic cardiomyopathy and dilated cardiomyopathy, Dr. Pinto arrived at a unifying concept of muscle function related to calcium sensitivity that is broadly applicable both to cardiac disease and potentially to muscular dystrophies as well. As Assistant Professor of Biomedical Sciences at the recently created Florida State University College of Medicine, Dr. Pinto is applying his prodigious talents and expertise in muscle biochemistry to numerous projects further exploring the mechanisms of this muscular function. Heart failure currently afflicts 6 million Americans and is the leading cause of heart death. Dr. Pinto is emerging as a leader in our scientific understanding of the underlying mechanism of disease, and new potential avenues for its cure.

Tori Gabriel, MBA-HA, FHRI's Director of Education & Prevention, hailed Dr. Pinto for his innovative approach to the study of heart muscle biochemistry when presenting the award. "Dr. Pinto is paving the way to novel approaches to our understanding and treatment of heart muscle dysfunction, a major component of congestive heart failure."

This prestigious award is granted to the individual within the State of Florida whose research is felt to have had the broadest impact on the advancement of knowledge in the diagnosis and/or treatment of cardiovascular disease. To be considered for the award, the researcher must be nominated by a colleague, conduct research within and be a resident of Florida, be active in the arena of clinical and/or basic science, and have reported the results of his or her work in the peer review arena of scientific meetings and/or publications. For his achievements in cardiovascular research, Dr. Pinto received \$25,000 from the Florida Heart Research Institute to be applied toward future cardiac research in Florida.

The award is given in conjunction with the Florida Heart Research Foundation, a subsidiary of FHRI, to promote Florida's **Stop Heart Disease** license plate that is now available to Florida residents. Proceeds from the sale of the specialty license plate are used for heart disease
