

Pursuant to the provisions of the District of Columbia Non-Profit Corporation Act, the undersigned adopts the following Amended and Restated Articles of Incorporation:

FIRST: The name of the corporation is:

REAL CLEAR FOUNDATION

SECOND: The period of its duration is perpetual.

THIRD: The specific and primary purposes for which this corporation is formed and for which it shall be exclusively administered and operated are to receive, administer for and expend funds in connection with the following charitable and educational purposes, and to support in other ways the following activities within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986:

- 1. To promote responsible journalism;
- 2. To promote think tanks made up of writers and other participants with the interest of educating the public;
- 3. To assist other charitable, educational, and social welfare organizations in the conduct of similar activities:
- 4. To engage in other charitable, educational, and social welfare activities as determined by the Board of Directors;

FOURTH: The Real Clear Foundation shall not have members.

FIFTH: The Directors shall be selected as provided in the bylaws.

SIXTH: No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of or be distributable to its members, directors, officers, or other private persons; except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article Third hereof;
