RESTATED UA CHARITABLE FUND AGREEMENT AND DECLARATION OF TRUST (FORMERLY THE UNITED ASSOCIATION EMERGENCY RELIEF FUND)

(Restated Effective March 1, 2014)

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, the United Association as Grantor and certain Trustees entered into an Agreement and Declaration of Trust Agreement establishing the United Association Emergency Relief Fund on November 1, 2001 and

WHEREAS, the Trustees desire to rename the Fund and make other amendments while continuing the terms of the Trust and enter into this Restated Trust Agreement effective the 1st day of March, 2014, and have the authority to amend the Trust Agreement pursuant to Article VI Section 1 of the original Agreement and Declaration of Trust.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Trustees in consideration of the promises and mutual covenants herein contained hereby declare that the Trustees shall hold in trust and shall administer, use and dispose of all property now and hereafter received by the Trustees as contributions, exclusively for the uses and charitable purposes and subject to the provisions hereinafter set forth.

ARTICLE 1 DEFINITIONS

Unless the context or subject matter requires otherwise, the following definitions shall govern in this Declaration of Trust:

Section 1. Grantor. The term "Grantor" as used herein shall mean the United Association of Journeymen and Apprentices of the Plumbing and Pipe Fitting Industry of the United States and Canada, AFL-CIO ("United Association").

Section 2. Trustees. The term "Trustees" as used herein shall mean the Trustees of the UA Charitable Fund, who shall be the General President and the General Secretary-Treasurer of the United Association and are designated as Trustees by virtue of holding the aforementioned offices of the United Association.

Section 3. Agreement and Declaration of Trust. The Term "Agreement and Declaration of Trust" or "Trust Agreement," as used herein, shall mean this instrument, including any amendments, supplements and modification hereto.

Section 4. Trust. The term "Trust" or "Trust Fund" as used herein shall mean the Trust continued by this Restated Declaration of Trust, and shall mean generally the monies and other things of value which comprise the corpus, income and additions to the Trust.

Section 5. Charitable Organization. The term "Charitable Organization" as used herein shall mean a corporation, trust fund, or community chest created or organized in the United States or any of its possessions, organized and operated exclusively for Charitable Purposes, no part of the net earnings of which inures or is payable to or for the benefit of any private shareholder or individual other than a scholarship recipient as provided in this Trust, and no substantial part of the activities of which is carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and which does not participate or intervene in (including the publishing or distributing of statements), any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. It is intended that the UA Charitable Fund Trust shall be a Charitable Organization as described in Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as now in force or hereafter amended, and as such entitled to exemption from federal income taxation.

Section 6. <u>Charitable Purposes.</u> The term "Charitable Purrposes" as used herein shall mean only those purposes permitted to be carried out by an organization exempt from federal

income taxation under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as now in force or hereafter amended.

Section 7. Act or Code. The terms "Act" or "Code" shall mean the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, its Regulations and any subsequent amendments.

ARTICLE II ESTABLISHMENT OF TRUST

Section 1. Name of Trust. The Trust, previously established as the United Association Emergency Relief Fund Trust, shall be known as the UA Charitable Fund Trust.

Section 2. Composition of Trust Fund. This Trust Fund consists of (1) such sums of money as have been or shall be paid to the Trust by the Donor; (2) any investments made therewith, the proceeds thereof and the income therefrom; (3) all other contributions, grants, payments and income to the Trustees from any source or party and any other assets used by the Trustees in the administration of the Trust.

Section 3. Purpose of Trust. This Trust is established and will be operated exclusively for Charitable Purposes within the United States and its possessions. In furtherance of these purposes, the Trustees shall:

- (a) receive, hold and administer assets and property exclusively for Charitable Purposes;
- (b) Assist and contribute to the support of exclusively Charitable Purposes;
- (c) Make and award donations, gifts, contributions and grants from income of the trust, in such amounts and to such recipients as the Trustees may determine, exclusively for Charitable Purposes;
- (d) engage in any and all activities necessary or useful to carry out the purposes of this Trust.

Section 4. Uses of Trust Property. The principal and income of all property received and accepted by the Trustees to be administered under this Restated Declaration of Trust shall be

held in trust by the Trustees, and they may make payments or distributions from the principal and income of the Trust for the above Charitable Purposes in such amounts as they may from time to time select and determine. No part of the net earnings of the Trust shall inure to the benefit of or be distributed to any private person or entity, except for Charitable Purposes consistent with the Trust Agreement and any adopted by-laws or rules and regulations, except that the Trust shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in this Trust Agreement. No substantial part of the activities of the Trust shall involve the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the Trust shall not participate or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of this Declaration of Trust, the Trust shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from federal income taxation under Section 501(c)(3) of the Act as now in force or hereafter amended.

ARTICLE III TRUSTEES

Section 1. Trustees. The operation and administration of the Trust shall be the responsibility of the Trustees. The following persons shall serve as the initial Trustees of the Restated Trust Agreement by virtue of holding the office of General President and General Secretary-Treasurer of the United Association: William P. Hite and Mark McManus.

Section 2. Acceptance of Trusteeship. A Trustee shall execute a written acceptance in a form satisfactory to the Trustees and thereby shall accept the Trust created and established by this Trust Agreement and consent to act as Trustee and to agree to administer the Trust as provided herein. Such written acceptance shall be filed at the office of the Trust.

Section 3. Term of Trustees. The Trustees shall serve while holding the office of the General President and General Secretary-Treasurer. Should the position of General President or General Secretary-Treasurer become vacant for any reason, the successors to such offices shall assume the position of Trustee.

Section 4. Replacement of Trustees. Any new Trustee designated to fill a vacancy shall accept such designation in writing as provided in Section 2 of this Article, and shall, without further act, become vested with all the rights, powers, discretion and duties of the predecessor Trustee.

Any retiring or terminated Trustee shall forthwith turn over to the Trustees at the office of the Trust any and all records, books, documents, monies and other property in the Trustees possession which are a part of the Trust and incident to the fulfillment of the Trustees' duties and responsibilities under this Restated Declaration of Trust.

The powers of the Trustees to act, as provided in this Trust Agreement, shall not be impaired or limited in any way pending the designation of a successor Trustee to fill any vacancy.

Section 5. Payment of Trustees. The Trustees shall not receive compensation for the performance of their duties as Trustees but may be reimbursed for all reasonable and necessary expenses which they incur in the performance of their duties.

ARTICLE IV MEETINGS AND DECISIONS OF THE TRUSTEES

Section 1. Officers of the Trustees. A Chairman shall be selected by majority vote of all of the Trustees. The Trustees shall select a Treasurer from among themselves.

Section 2. Meetings of the Trustee. The Trustees shall meet at least once each year and at such other times as the Trustees deem necessary to transact their business. Action by the

Trustees at a meeting shall be by majority decision of the Trustees then in office. Two Trustees shall constitute a quorum for any meeting.

Section 3. Action of Trustees Without Meeting. Action by the Trustees may also be taken without a meeting by writing, by telephone conference call or by wire, provided that in such cases, there shall be unanimous written concurrence of all the Trustees in the action agreed upon.

Section 4. Record of Trustee Action. The Trustees or their designee shall keep minutes of all meetings and records of Trustee decisions reached without a meeting, but such records need not be verbatim. Copies of the minutes and records of decisions shall be sent to all Trustees.

ARTICLE V POWERS AND DUTIES OF TRUSTEES

Section 1. Conduct of Trust Business. The Trustees shall have authority to control and manage the operation and administration of the UA Charitable Fund Trust and shall conduct the business and activities of the UA Charitable Fund Trust in accordance with this Trust Agreement, bylaws and applicable law. The Trustees shall hold, manage and protect the Trust Fund and collect the income therefrom and any contribution thereto.

Section 2. Use of the Trust Fund for Expenses and for Trust Purposes.

(a) The Trustees shall have the power and authority to use and apply the Trust Fund to pay or provide for the payment of all reasonable and necessary expenses of administering the affairs of this Trust, including the purchase or lease of premises, material, supplies and equipment, of employing administrative, accounting, legal, clerical and other assistants or employees as they may find necessary or appropriate, and of performing such other acts as the Trustees, in their sole discretion, find necessary or appropriate in the performance of their duties.

(b) The Trustees shall have the power and authority to use and apply the Trust Fund to pay or provide for the payment of expenses incurred in the administration and operation of the Trust in furtherance of its Charitable Purposes in accordance with the terms, provisions and conditions of this Trust Agreement and the bylaws to be agreed upon by the Trustees pursuant to this Declaration of Trust.

Section 3. Construction and Determinations by Trustees. Subject to the stated purposes of the UA Charitable Fund Trust and the provisions of this Restated Trust Agreement, the Trustees shall have full power to construe the provisions of this Restated Declaration of Trust and any bylaws adopted hereunder.

Section 4. Determination of Eligibility.

The Trustees shall make all determinations regarding the eligibility for and award of any donations, gifts, contributions, or grants from the income of the Trust.

Section 5. General Powers. The Trustees are hereby empowered, in addition to such other powers as are set forth herein or conferred by law, to:

(a) invest, reinvest and have invested and reinvested all funds of this Trust, without distinction between principal and income, in any type of investment the Trustees deem prudent. There shall be no limitation restricting investments in common stock to a percentage of the Trust Fund or to a percentage of the total market value of the Trust Fund. The Trustees shall have the authority, in respect to any stocks, bonds or other property, real or personal, held by them as Trustees, to exercise all such rights, powers and privileges as might be lawfully exercised by any person owning similar stocks, bonds or other property in his own right;

- (b) register securities or other Trust property in the name of the Trust or of the Trustees, or in the names of one or more nominees of the Trustees and to hold instruments in bearer form;
- (c) enter into and terminate agency or custody agreements with banks or trust companies chosen by them, under which said agreements the Trustees may turn over to said banks or trust companies a portion or all of the funds held by them in this Trust for safekeeping, investment or reinvestment, on such terms as the Trustees deem advisable;
- (d) compromise, settle or adjust any claim or demands in favor of or against the Trust or the Trustees on such terms and conditions as the Trustees may deem advisable; commence and defend any legal, equitable or administrative proceedings brought in connection with the Trust and represent the Trust in all such proceedings;
- (e) sell, exchange, lease, convey, mortgage or dispose of any property, whether real or personal, at any time forming a part of the Trust upon such terms as they may deem proper, and to execute and deliver any and all instruments of conveyance, lease mortgage and transfer in connection therewith;
- (f) pay or provide for the payment of all real and personal property taxes, income taxes and other taxes of any and all kind levied or assessed under existing or future laws upon or in respect to the Trust or any money, property or securities forming a part thereof;
- (g) retain such portion of the monies of the Trust in cash balances awaiting investment or as the Trustees may deem desirable, without any liability for interest thereon;
- (h) establish and accumulate as part of the Trust such reasonable reserve funds as the Trustees, in their sole discretion, deem necessary or desirable to carry out the purposes of this Trust;

- (i) allocate fiduciary responsibilities among the Trustees or Committees of the Trustees, delegate fiduciary duties to persons other than Trustees and delegate Trustee responsibilities, to an investment manager as provided in this Restated Agreement and Declaration of Trust;
- (j) engage one or more independent certified public accountants, qualified legal counsel and other agents or employees to perform all services as may be required by applicable law and such other services as the Trustees may deem necessary;
- (k) appoint an investment manager(s) or investment trustee(s), and enter into an agreement with such manager or trustee, delegating to such manager or trustee the responsibility to control and manage, including the power to acquire and dispose of, such of the assets of the Trust Fund as the Trustees may specify;
- (1) employ a reputable and qualified investment consultant to assist the Trustees in exercising their investment powers and authority by reviewing the investment policy and types of investments made by the Trustees and/or the investment manager(s);
- (m) pay or provide for the payment from the Trust Fund of all costs incurred in employing professionals, consultants, and managers as the Trustees deem necessary and in accordance with this Trust Agreement and applicable law;
- (n) obtain and maintain policies of insurance, to the extent permitted by law, to insure themselves, the Trust as such, as well as employees or agents of the Trustees and of the Trust while engaged in business-related activities for and on behalf of the Trust with respect to injuries received or property damage suffered by them. The cost of the premiums for such policies of insurance shall be paid out of the Trust;

- (o) establish such Bylaws as may be necessary to effectuate the purposes of this Declaration of Trust and not inconsistent with the terms hereof;
 - (p) designate an agent for service of legal process for the Trust Fund;
- (q) enter into any and all contracts and agreements for carrying out the terms of this

 Trust Agreement and the operation and administration of the UA Charitable Fund Trust; and
- (r) do any and all acts, whether or not expressly authorized herein, which the Trustees, in their discretion may deem necessary to accomplish the Charitable Purposes of this Trust.

Section 6. Personal Liability. Each Trustee shall be liable or responsible only for his own acts or omissions in bad faith. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing, no Trustee shall be liable for the actions or omissions of any other Trustee, or of any predecessor or any officer, agent, depository or employee selected with reasonable care.

The Trustees, to the extent permitted by law, shall incur no liability in acting upon any instrument, application, notice, request, signed letter, telegram, paper or document believed by them to be genuine and to contain a true statement of facts, and to be signed by the proper person.

Section 7. Reliance by Others. No party dealing with the Trustees shall be obligated to see to the application of any funds or property of the Trust to the stated Trust or to see that the terms of this Trust Agreement and bylaws adopted hereunder have been complied with or to inquire into the necessity or expediency of any act of the Trustees. Every instrument executed by the Trustees shall be conclusive evidence in favor of every person relying thereon that at the time of the execution of said instrument, the Trust was in full force and effect, that the instrument was executed in accordance with the terms and conditions of this Trust Agreement and bylaws

adopted hereunder, and that the Trustees were duly authorized and empowered to execute the instrument.

Section 8. Books of Account. The Trustees shall cause to be kept true and accurate books of account and records of all transactions of the Trust, which shall be open to the inspection of each of the Trustees at all times and which shall be audited annually and at such times as the Trustees deem appropriate by a certified public accountant selected by the Trustees.

Section 9. Execution of Documents. The Trustees may, in the course of conducting the business of the Trust, execute all instruments, documents or notices in the name of the UA Charitable Fund Trust, which instruments shall be signed by the Chairman or a Trustee or Trustees designated by resolution. All persons shall be fully protected in reliance that such instruments, documents or notices have been duly authorized and are binding on the Trustees and the Trust.

Section 10. Distribution of Income. The Trustees shall distribute Trust income from each taxable year at such time and in such manner so as not to subject the Trust to the tax on undistributed income imposed by Section 4942 of the Code, or the corresponding provisions of any subsequent tax law.

Section 11. Self-Dealing Prohibited. The Trustees shall not engage in any act of self-dealing as defined in Section 4941(d) of the Code, or corresponding provisions of any subsequent tax law.

Section 12. Retention of Excess Business Holdings. The Trustees shall not cause the Trust to retain any excess business holdings as defined in Section 4943(c) of the Code which would subject the Trust to taxation under Section 4943 of the Code or corresponding provisions of any subsequent tax law.

Section 13. Investments. The Trustees shall not cause the Trust to make any investments which would subject the Trust to taxation under Section 4944 of the Code or corresponding provisions of any subsequent tax law.

Section 14. Expenditures. The Trustees shall not cause the Trust to make any taxable expenditures as defined in Section 4945(d) of the Code, or corresponding provisions of any subsequent tax law.

Section 15. Non-Discrimination. The Trustees shall comply with all requirements of the Code and particularly of Section 4945(g) thereof requiring that awards be made on an objective and non-discriminatory basis.

ARTICLE VI AMENDMENT OF DECLARATION TRUST

Section 1. Amendment by Trustees. The provisions of this Declaration of Trust may be amended at any time by an instrument in writing adopted by unanimous action of the Trustees. No amendment shall authorize the Trustees to conduct the affairs of this Trust or permit any use or purpose contrary to the requirements of Section 501(c)(3) of the Code, as now in force or as hereafter amended.

Section 2. Retroactive Effect. Any amendment to this Declaration of Trust may have retroactive effect if deemed necessary by the Trustees.

ARTICLE VII TERMINATION OF TRUST

- Section 1. Termination. This Trust may be terminated by an instrument in writing executed by the Trustees.
- Section 2. Procedure on Termination. In the event of the termination of this Declaration of Trust, the Trustees shall:

- (a) make provision out of the Trust for the payment of expenses incurred up to the date of termination of the Trust and the expenses incidental to such termination;
- (b) arrange for a final audit and report of their transactions and accounts for the purpose of termination of their trusteeship;
- (c) give any notice and prepare and file any reports which they deem appropriate or which may be required by law; and
- (d) dispose of all assets of the Trust exclusively for the purposes of the Trust Fund in such manner, or to such organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for Charitable Purposes as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Code, as the Trustees shall determine.

No part of the corpus or income of the Trust shall be used for or diverted to purposes other than exclusively for Charitable Purposes.

Section 3. Notification of Termination. Upon termination of the Trust, in accordance with this Article, the Union shall forthwith notify the Trustees and any other interested party. The Trustees shall continue as Trustees for the purpose of winding up the affairs of the Trust.

ARTICLE VIII MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS

Section 1. Situs. This Declaration of Trust is accepted by the Trustees in the State of Maryland and such place shall be deemed the situs of the Trust Fund continued hereunder. All questions pertaining to validity, construction and administration of the Trust shall be determined in accordance with the laws of the United States and of the State of Maryland.

Section 2. Notice. Any notice required to be given to the Trustees or any one or more of the Trustees pursuant to any provision of this Trust Agreement shall be deemed to have been given if mailed to such Trustee or Trustees at the last known address of the Trustee.

Section 3. Compliance with Tax Laws. It is the intent of the parties hereto that this Trust qualify and continue to qualify as a Charitable Organization under 501(c)(3) of the Code and an exempt private foundation under Section 509(a)(1) of the Code. The provisions of this Trust Agreement and any bylaws adopted hereunder shall at all times be interpreted and administered in a manner to sustain such intent. The Trustees are authorized to amend this Trust Agreement for the sole purpose of complying with the requirements of the Act and any regulations applicable to such Charitable Organizations.
