	information or resources needed to spay/neuter pets in the community. In 2013, HSLC facilitated the spay/neuter of 656
	animals under the following programs: Discount Green Sheet Certificates, Pit Fix, Foster S/N and Community Financial Assistance,
	signifcantly reducing the homeless pet population in our county. It is estimated that one unaltered cat can produce up to 130 kittens
	over a three year period. These programs provide low cost spay/neuter services for cats, dogs, Pit breeds, and pet rabbits.
