NCAR is exempt from federal and state income taxes under the provisions of Section 501 (c)(6) of the Internal Revenue Code and applicable state tax statutes. NCAR is subject to unrelated business income taxes for royalties received from NCAR Service Corporation, rent, advertising and management services provided in excess of related expenses. At December 31, 2013 and 2012, there was a federal net operating loss carryforward of \$269,294 and \$235,775, respectively, and a state net operating loss tax carryforward of \$225,894 and \$192,375, respectively. The net operating loss carryforwards begin to expire in 2025 for federal purposes and 2020 for state purposes. NCAR's wholly-owned subsidiary is subject to federal and state corporate income taxes. At December 31, 2013, NCAR Service Corporation had no federal tax liability.

The organization's policy is to evaluate all tax positions to identify those that may be considered uncertain. All identified material tax

positions are assessed and measured by a "more-likely-than-not" threshold to determine if the benefit of an uncertain tax position should be recognized in the financial statements. For the year ending December 31, 2013, there were no uncertain tax positions.

The tax returns for the organization and its subsidiary are subject to examination by the Internal Revenue Service and the North Carolina Department of Revenue, generally for three years after they are filed.
