(3) identifies five factors that are to be considered. First, an organization must be organized and operated to attract new and additional public support on a continuous basis. The Coca-Cola Scholars Foundation satisfies this requirement since it regularly solicits funds from non-participating bottlers and has done so since its incorporation. In addition, in 1994 the Foundation began soliciting contributions from corporations and individuals other than bottlers. This new qualified source of contributions is expected to grow in future years, thus, increasing the percentage of qualified support.

Second, the percentage of support received from the public is considered. The higher the percentage above 10 percent, the lesser is the burden of establishing the publicly supported nature of the organization through other factors. The Coca-Cola Scholars Foundation exceeds the 10 percent minimum threshold.

Third, the actual sources of support are to be considered. Support received directly or indirectly from a representative number of persons rather than from members of a single family is viewed more favorably. The foundation received support from a large number of independent bottlers in addition to those related through common ownership. In fact, over 90 percent of all Coca-Cola bottling volume participates in the program. This support is a favorable factor.

In addition, the Coca-Cola Scholars Foundation receives contributions from

bottlers based upon their sales. In effect, the Foundation derives its support indirectly from purchases by the general public. Therefore, even the contributions received from one donor under the related party rules are traceable to purchases by the general public. In other words, substantially all of the Foundation's support is derived indirectly from the general public.

Finally, the fact that an organization is of the type that provides services directly for the benefit of the general public on a continuing basis is considered evidence that such an organization is publicly supported. The Coca-Cola Scholars Foundation clearly provides such services by offering scholarship programs available to all high school seniors attending school in participating bottlers' territories. Beginning in 2000, the Foundation also began offering scholarship programs to persons attending two-year degree granting institutions. In addition to providing one of the nation's largest corporate sponsored scholarship programs, the program eliminates any semblance of private benefit by declaring all children and grandchildren of employees, officers, or owners of Coca-Cola Bottling Companies, The Coca-Cola Company, or any bottler or Company divisions or subsidiaries ineligible for consideration.

The Coca-Cola Scholars Foundation Board of Directors consists of nine members. Two members are appointed from The Coca-Cola Company, Four members are elected by the Coca-Cola Bottlers' Association, and the remaining three members have been elected from the bottling community. Each year, 200 Scholars are selected to receive four-year renewable scholarships valued at \$2,500 per year. Also, 51 Scholars receive four-year renewable scholarships

valued at \$5,000 per year. Therefore, The Coca-Cola Scholars Foundation is allowing over 1000 adolescents the opportunity to attend college each year. In addition, through the Coca-Cola Two-Year College Scholarship Program, 400 community college students are selected to receive a one-time \$1,000 scholarship each year.

Upon review of the factors listed in Treasury Regulation §1.170a-9(c), each of the factors are favorable to the Foundation's contention it is a public charity. Therefore, we believe the Coca-Cola Scholars Foundation clearly satisfies the 10 percent test and qualifies as a public charity.
