PART I LINE 2: Funds allocated for special projects outside of the US are proposed to the MRN Board of Directors either by US Missionary staff members serving abroad or by denominational leaders from the nations where MRN serves to support church planting efforts. Proposal are entertained only if national leaders on the respective fields approve of the projects and agree to provide budgets and accountability for the use of the funds provided. When a project is approved by the MRN Board, it may be funded from the general fund or by special gifts contributed by US church partners and individual donors or by a combination of these sources. Accountability for the appropriate use of the funds is the joint responsibility of the national denominational leaders involved and the MRN staff serving on a given field overseas.

In Novosibirsk there is a single recipient - a national church that is served by an MRN staff member who provides counsel, leadership training, preaching assistance and mentoring. This church asked for pastoral support this year for a single national worker. In Bosnia Hercegovina, the Evangelical Church of Bosnia Hercegovina is supplied with support that is used by the national presbyters to compensate a variety of church projects and national pastors. Funds are provided only at the request of the national presbyters and they distribute the funds as they will. Line 2 reflects the sum of funds provided for six national workers. Support levels among these six individuals range from \$500 to \$10,500 for the year.
