ARTICLE 2. <u>NEW.NAME</u>

The Board of Directors of the Corporation has adopted an amendment to the Corporation's Articles of Incorporation changing the name of the Corporation from Amos – Cheves Foundation, Inc. to Lockwood Parthers Foundation, Inc.

ARTICLE 3. AMENDMENT

Article 1 of the Articles of Incorporation is hereby amended by deleting the full sentence containing the reference to Amos – Cheves Foundation, Inc. and substituting in lieu thereof the following new full sentence:

"The name of the corporation is Lockwood Partners Foundation, Inc."
