Any funds not so expended must be returned to BTF.

2. Annual Report. Beloco shall provide an annual narrative and financial report to BTF as soon as possible following BTF's tax year to which the report relates, and shall make available any reports, publications, or other materials prepared in connection with Beloco's programs or activities.

3. Financial Records. Beloco shall maintain financial records pertaining to the grant in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles, and shall maintain receipts and other documentation in connection with the grant for at least four years. All such records shall be open for BTF's inspection at any time during that period.

4. Restrictions on Use of Funds. No funds shall be used to:

(a) Carry on propaganda, or otherwise attempt to influence legislation (within the meaning of section 4945(d)(1) of the Code);

(b) Influence the outcome of any specific public election, or carry on, directly or indirectly, any voter registration drive (within the meaning of section 4945(d)(2) of the Code);

(c) Make an individual grant or re-grant funds to another organization unless the requirements of section 4945 of the Code are met; or

(d) Advance any other purpose other than one specified in section 170(c)(2)(B) of the Code.

5. Misuse of Funds. If BTF becomes aware that the funds are not being used for the purposes described above, it reserves the right to ask to be reimbursed for the amounts so diverted, and shall withhold any future grant payments.

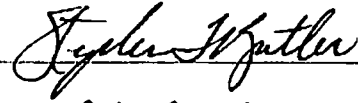

Beloco does not use any of its funds to (a) carry on propaganda, or otherwise attempt to influence legislation (within the meaning of section 4945(d)(1) of the Code); (b) influence the outcome of any specific public election, or carry on, directly or indirectly, any voter registration drive (within the meaning of section 4945(d)(2) of the Code); (c) make an individual grant or re-grant funds to another organization unless the requirements of section 4945 of the Code are met; or (d) advance any other purpose other than one specified in section 170(c)(2)(B) of the Code.
6. BTF is satisfied that Beloco will use the grants from BTF for the proper charitable purposes for which the grants are being distributed.

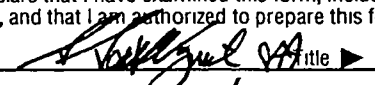
