


Sponsor a Life Program - Through the sponsorship of babies, children, widows, and vulnerable women, Watoto plans to care for 10,000 children by 2023. Over 400 children rescued by Watoto have now reached adulthood and have graduated from the program with the life skills and education they needed to be independent thanks to sponsorship. Watoto graduates include professions such as teachers, doctors, lawyers, farmers and engineers, among others. Watoto's holistic model involves physical care, medical intervention including HIV/AIDS treatment, education - both formal and technical, trauma counseling, and spiritual discipleship.

4b (Code:) (Expenses \$ 662,041, including grants of \$ 0) (Revenue \$ 0)

Choir Tours - Accompanied by a team of adults, the children's choir presents Watoto's vision and mission through their stories, music and dance. Watoto choirs act as ambassadors to raise awareness about the plight of the orphaned and vulnerable children of Africa. This experience benefits the children academically, socially, emotionally and spiritually and is designed to train and equip them as future leaders. Since the choir's inception in 1994, over 1,000 children have had the opportunity to tour with the choir and over 1 million people in the U.S. have experienced a choir production and have learned about the plight of African orphans.

Watoto Mission Teams - Over 200 teams have traveled to Uganda from the U.S. There are two types of teams: -Build Teams are groups of people, often from churches, that travel to Africa to provide practical help in building structures in our Watoto villages. This could be a home, classroom, teacher's home, etc. -Medical Teams are groups of medical professionals that go to Africa and offer their medical expertise to treat the Watoto babies, children, and women and also to provide training to the Watoto medical personnel on staff.
