Prior to signing and filing with the IRS, a copy of Form 990 is provided to the Governing Board for their review. Only after their review

and unanimous approval is the Form 990 signed and filed with the IRS. The copy of Schedule B that was provided to the Governing Board

appeared without the donors names and addresses to protect the confidentiality of those donors.

**Line 15 a. The organization's CEO, Executive Director, or top management official .**

"Yes". The process for determining the compensation of the CEO included the research, analysis, review and deliberations conducted by

independent members of the Compensation Committee. The Compensation Committee used comparability data obtained from GuideStar,

GuideStar Compensation Report, 11th Edition September 2011 for their research, analysis and review and also a number of other factors.

At the conclusion of their work the Compensation Committee documented their analysis, considerations, methodology, deliberations, final conclusions and decision in a Compensation Report. Upon the Compensation Committee's unanimous acceptance and approval of this

Report it then became a part of the Official Records of the Organization for the CEO's compensation. This comprehensive review and report was completed December 31, 2011. A semi-annual review was conducted by the Compensation Committee in June and December of 2013.
