

Graduating high school seniors who have lived in El



Dorado, Placer, Yolo or Sacramento County, California, for at least two years prior to the time of application and also meet California State residency requirements.

Students who are planning to enroll full-time at an accredited two or four year college, university or vocational/technical institution located within 100 miles of the Sacramento County Courthouse.

### THE APPLICATION PROCESS

The online application for the Schwab-Rosenhouse Memorial Scholarship was due February 25, 2014. Eligible applicants must complete the online application and submit high school transcripts, test scores, and letters of recommendation.

### WHO ADMINISTERS THE SCHOLARSHIP?

The Schwab-Rosenhouse Memorial Scholarship Fund is administered by International Scholarship and Tuition Services, Inc. (ISTS). ISTS will manage the online application process, appoint the selection committee, notify winners and non-winners, confirm enrollment status, and distribute scholarship funds on behalf of the Schwab-Rosenhouse Memorial Scholarship Fund.

Headquartered in Nashville, Tenn., ISTS specializes in providing scholarship, grant and tuition program management services to corporations, foundations, associations and other philanthropic and gift-giving organizations.

### THE SELECTION PROCESS

The selection committee will evaluate each candidate's academic record, school and community activities,

volunteer activities, and other personal circumstances. Responses to questions related to future education and career plans also will be an important factor in the evaluation process. The ratings provided by the selection committee will be used by ISTS to designate finalists for further consideration.

### SCHOLARSHIP AWARD AMOUNTS

Schwab-Rosenhouse Memorial Scholarship awards range from \$1,000 to \$5,000 per year.
