Part XV Purpose of Grants or Contributions

American Shetland Sheepdog Association (Sheltie Rescue Network) takes in abandoned, lost, and unwanted Shelties and attempt to find them new, loving homes. All rescue dogs are vetchecked, vaccinated, spayed or neutered and often nursed back to health. They are fostered in temporary SRN homes, so each dog can be evaluated and the most appropriate permanent placement made. The goal is to find the right home for each dog regardless of the time it takes.

Boys and Girls Club of the Virginia Peninsula provides cultural, educational, and recreational activities to help youth overcome obstacles and achieve success. The organization emphasizes character development and responsible citizenship and is presented in a manner that is engaging and fun. There are a variety of sports and after school programs that provide supervision and safe places to learn and grow and develop ongoing relationships with caring, adult professionals.

Cleveland Coutny CASA, Inc. is a court appointed non-profit advocacy group serving Cleveland, Garvin and McClain counties. CASA speaks up for children who have been abused or neglected and need a voice in the child welfare system. CASA's community volunteers are trained court advocates who give a voice to children who have no one to represent their best interests.

Eden Clinic (Formerly Care Net) Provides pregnancy testing, counseling, education, and material assistance. Counseling includes education on the three options for an unexpected pregnancy. Education includes pregnancy, childbirth, parenting. Ultrasound equipment is available for expecting mothers to get to know their baby prior to its birth. Material Assistance includes baby clothing, diapers, baby accessories and baby furniture. Referrals to other agencies are made as needed.

Deaconess Pregnancy and Adoption Services - Assists women in crisis pregnancies and provides adoption services.

Deliverance Ministries, Inc. is a non-profit, non-denominational, volunteer-reliant ministry providing group education and individual counseling and prayer with a focus on deliverance and inner healing. The program stresses that deliverance is not a one time quick fix, but rather an important part of identifying issues and equipping people with methods and tools to gain freedom from harmful strongholds that are hindering their lives.

Food and Shelter for Friends of Norman Oklahoma provides hot daily meals for needy people and temporary shelter for homeless families in transition and counseling to encourage employment and resolving other problems of the homeless.

Journey Church - Youth Scholarships and disaster relief.

Kappa Sigma Endowment Fund (Scholarship Fund) - Provides deserving students educational funding who excel in the areas of scholarship, leadership, fellowship and service.

LoveWorks - Provides after school and summer programs for middle school youth, where they are helped to discover their gifts, talents and strengths and possible vocations through tutoring, life skills training, team work, community service, and leadership development.

Oklahoma United Methodist Circle of Care is a Methodist-based agency whose mission is to provide help, healing and wholeness to children, youth and families who are hurting by helping people make better choices, live happier lives, and find hope and promise in their futures. COC combines Christian influence with a therapeutic continuum of professional services. COC's residential group homes include the United Methodist Boy's Ranch in Gore, Frances E. Willard Home for Girls in Tulsa, and the United Methodist Children's Home in Tahlequah. Foster care through Child Share helps place children in homes through local church congregations and provides care for the changing physical, emotional and spiritual needs of individuals.

Norman Regional Health Foundation - supports the Norman Regional Health System to provide outpatient diagnostic centers, medical equipment, updated cutting edge medical equipment and facilities and scholarships for students in various areas of medical education.

Novo Ministries is an inner city ministry for children and youth offering after school, evening and summer initiatives.

Oklahoma Jail-Prison Fellowship is a non-profit, volunteer-reliant ministry ministering directly to jail and prison inmates through counseling and Bible study. Thousands of prisoners are touched every year by OJPF with nearly 2,000 professions of faith annually. OJPF is currently exploring a means of partnering with local churches to offer follow-up support for individuals once they are released.

Salvation Army- (Norman, Okla.) assists needy people with a variety of programs including food, clothing and temporary shelter.

Samaritan's Purse is a nondenominational Christian organization providing spiritual and physical aid to hurting people around the world. Since 1970 Samaritan's Purse has helped meet needs of people who are victims of war, poverty, natural disasters, disease and famine with the purpose of relieving human suffering and sharing God's love.

United Way of Norman - provides funds for a variety of charitable organizations serving the Norman, Oklahoma area.
